

# MIS Student Financial Aid, SF (Applicants): Descriptive Statistics for the 2019-20, 2020-21 & 2021-22 Academic Year

# Introduction

The 2021-22 MIS Financial Aid reports (SF, FA) for the Foothill-De Anza CDD were submitted by the FHDA CCD (Foothill-De Anza Community College District) to the CCCCO (California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office) on December 10, 2022. This document shows descriptive statistics for the MIS SF (Financial Aid Applicants) report for this reporting year and compare the data with that submitted for for the last two academic years (i.e., 2019-20 and 2020-21).

# Data Highlights

The following includes key findings shown by the data in the tables at the end of this section.

- Data in Table 1 show that the number of students who received at least one financial aid award or scholarship at the FHDA CCD dropped 12% (minus 1,749) in 2021-22, compared to the number for 2020-21. At the college level, data in this table show a 10% drop (minus 925) for De Anza, and a 15% drop (minus 915) for Foothill for the same period.
- Financial aid headcount data in Table 1 correlate with enrollment headcount data in Table 2. Data for credit students in Table 2 show a drop of about 12% at the district level between the last two academic years; at the college level, the data show a drop of 9% and 16% for credit students at De Anza and Foothill, respectively.
- Data disaggregated by budget status (SF03) in Table 3 show the largest drop in headcount for financial aid students not living with their parents ("Off campus budget")—a drop of 18% and 19% at De Anza and Foothill, respectively, between the last two academic years. For students living at home with parents, the data show a drop of 6% and 8% at De Anza and Foothill, respectively, during this period.

- Data in Table 4 show that the median budget amount (SF04) increased significantly in 2021-22 over the prior academic year for most financial aid students; an increase of 11% to 48%. The "Off campus budget" (students not living with parents) group at De Anza was the only group that show a drop in the median budget amount: a 15% drop (\$36,944 in 2021-22 from \$43,292 the prior year).
- Data disaggregated by dependency status data (SF05) in Table 5 show similar percentage drops across colleges for independent student headcounts between 2020-21 and 2021-22: De Anza data show a drop of 20% (minus 763); Foothill, 19% (minus 528). By contrast, the number of dependent students at De Anza declined by just 4% (minus 215), which is significantly less when compared to a percentage drop of 14% (minus 358) at Foothill during the same period.
- Data for household size (SF06) disaggregated by dependency status (SF05) in Table 6 show that the average household size for dependent students at De Anza or Foothill is about 4; for independent students, about 1.5.
- Data for marital status (SF07, position 1) in Table 7 show that about 5% of financial aid students at De Anza in 2021-22 were married, compared to about 6% at Foothill. When excluding "unknowns," the percentage of married students at Foothill increased to 8%.
- Data for the number of dependents (SF07, position 2) in Table 8 show that less than 3% of financial aid students at De Anza in 2021-22 had at least one dependent; similar results are shown for Foothill, about 3% with at least one dependent (3.6% not counting unknowns). The number of financial aid students with at least one dependent declined by about 25% in 2021-22 at both colleges, when compared to the number for the prior year.
- The median for the expected family contribution (EFC, SF17) for financial aid students increased significantly between 2020-21 and 2021-22 at both colleges. Data in Figure 9 show that at De Anza the median EFC increased to \$2,690 in 2021-22 from \$1,838 the previous year (46% increase); at Foothill, the EFC increased to \$2,355 from \$1,125 (more than doubled) during the same period.



#### MIS Student Financial Aid: Student Headcount by College and Academic Year





# Figure 2 Student Headcount by Institution, Credit Status and Academic Year



## SF03 Budget Category: Headcount by College and Academic Year





#### SF04 Budget Amount: Median Amount by Budget Category, College and Academic Year




SF05 Student-Aid-Dependency-Status: Headcount by College and Academic Year

## SF05 Student-Aid-Dependency-Status: Headcount by College and Academic Year



## SF06 Student-Aid-Household-Size: Average by Dependency Status, College and Academic Year




SF07 Position 1, Student Marital Status: Headcount by College and Academic Year

SF06 Student-Aid-Household-Size: Average by Dependency Status, College and Academic Year


