## MIS Student Financial Aid Applicant (SF): Summary Statistics for 2023-24

### Introduction

The 2023-24 MIS Financial Aid reports –financial aid applicant (SF) and financial aid award (FA) – were submitted to the CCCCCO (California Community Colleges Chancellor’s Office) by the FHDA CCD (Foothill-De Anza Community College District) on October 18, 2024. In this document, we compare data in the MIS SF report for the last three academic years (i.e., 2021-22, 2022-23, 2023-24), including students’ budget category and amount, dependency status, household size, marital status, number of dependents, income, and expected family contribution.

### Data Highlights

These are key findings shown in tables and figures at the end of this document.

- Data in Table 1 shows that the number of students who enrolled in at least one credit course at FHDA in 2023-24 increased 6.5% (50,360 from 47,306) when compared to the prior academic year. Data disaggregated by college show an increase of 7.9% (28,622 from 26,515) at De Anza and 5.0% (24,473 from 23,305) at Foothill for the same group and period.
- Data in Table 2 shows that the number of FHDA students who received any type of financial aid or scholarship increased 10.9% (14,810 from 13,353) in 2023-24, compared to the prior academic year. At De Anza, the number increased by 14.6% (10,411 from 9,086); at Foothill, it increased 5.1% (5,315 from 5,055).
- Data for De Anza disaggregated by *budget status* (SF03) in Table 3 shows that in 2023-24 there was a significantly higher-than-expected increase in the number of students with an *off-campus* budget, 39.6% (4,869 from 3,468), when compared to the academic prior year. Foothill data in this table shows a headcount increase of 9.6% (2,272 from 2,073) for the same group and period.

- Regarding changes in the last two academic years for the median *budget amount* (SF04), data in Table 4 shows the same percentage increase across colleges for students *living with parents*, 8.6%, or those with *off-campus* budget, 7.9%. In 2023-24 the median budget amount for FHDA students *living with parents* was about \$28,900; with *off-campus* budget, \$40,868.
- Data disaggregated by *dependency status* (SF05) in Table 5 shows that the number of *independent* students at De Anza increased 50.4% in 2023-24, significantly higher-than-expected when compared to the number for the prior academic year (4,415 from 2,936). At Foothill, the number of *independent* students increased 8.2% (2,321 from 2,145) during the same period.
- Data for *household size* (SF06) disaggregated by *dependency status* (SF05) in Table 6 shows that at both colleges the *3-year average* household size for *dependent* students was 3.9; for independent students, 1.7.
- Data for *marital status* (SF07, position 1) in Table 7 shows that the percentage of financial aid students at Foothill who reported being *unmarried* increased 5.8 percentage points (87.5% from 81.6%) in 2023-24 over the prior academic year; at De Anza, 2.5 percentage points (91.9% from 89.4%).
- Data for *number of dependents* (SF07, position 2) in Table 8 shows that in 2023-24 the number of financial aid students at De Anza with at least one dependent increased 113.9% (370 from 173) over the prior academic year. In 2023-24, 3.6% of financial aid students at De Anza had at least one dependent; at Foothill, 2.4%.
- Data in Figure 9 shows that median expected family contribution (EFC, SF17) for financial aid student at De Anza dropped 63.1% (\$1,046 from \$2,835) in 2023-24, compared to the prior year. At Foothill, it increased 1.8% (\$1,941 from \$1,907) during the same period.

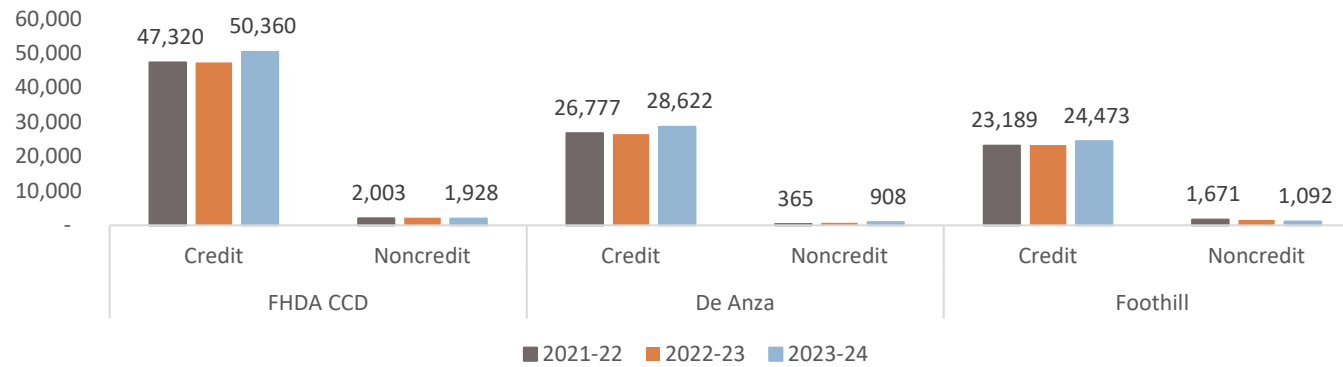

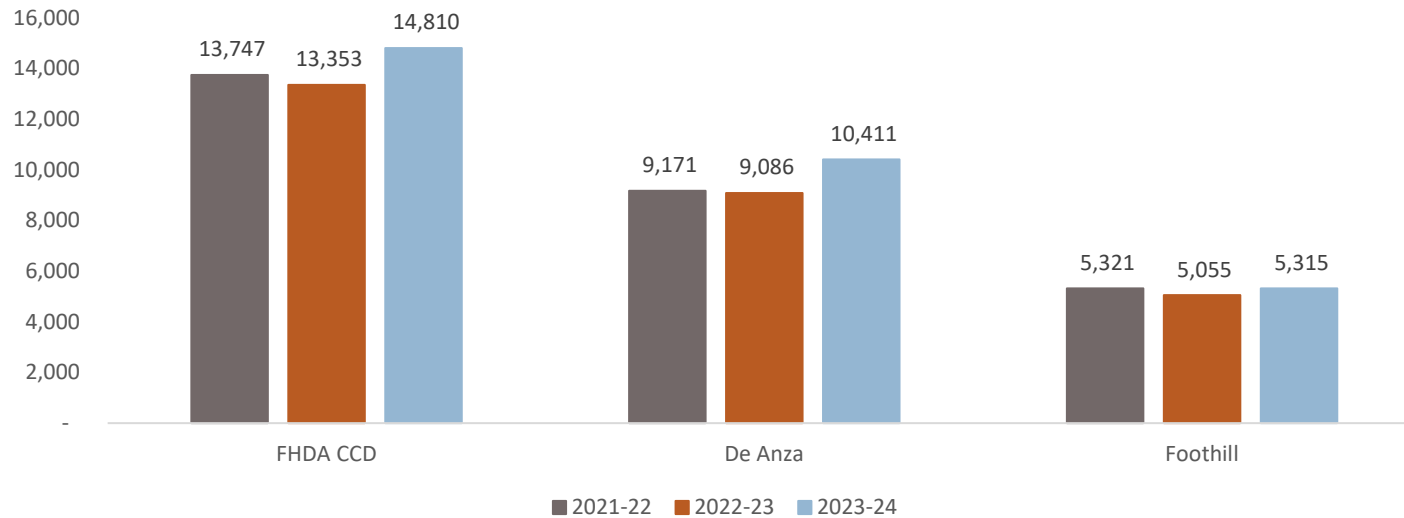

**MIS Student Financial Aid: Student Headcount by College and Academic Year**



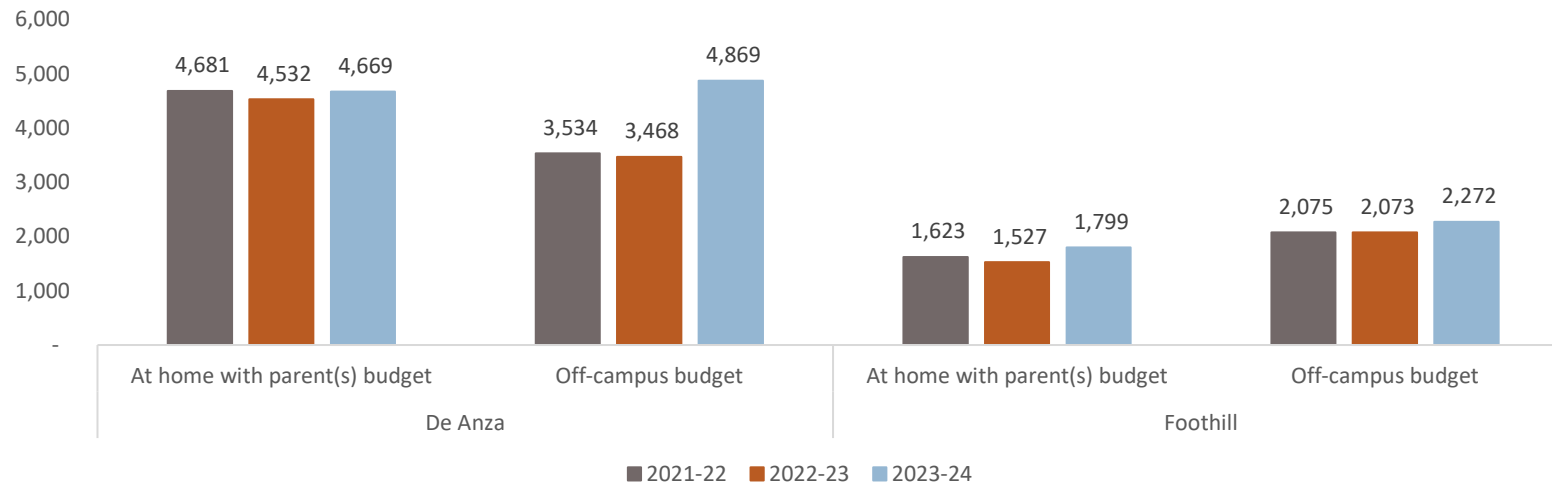

**SF03 Budget Category: Headcount by College and Academic Year**



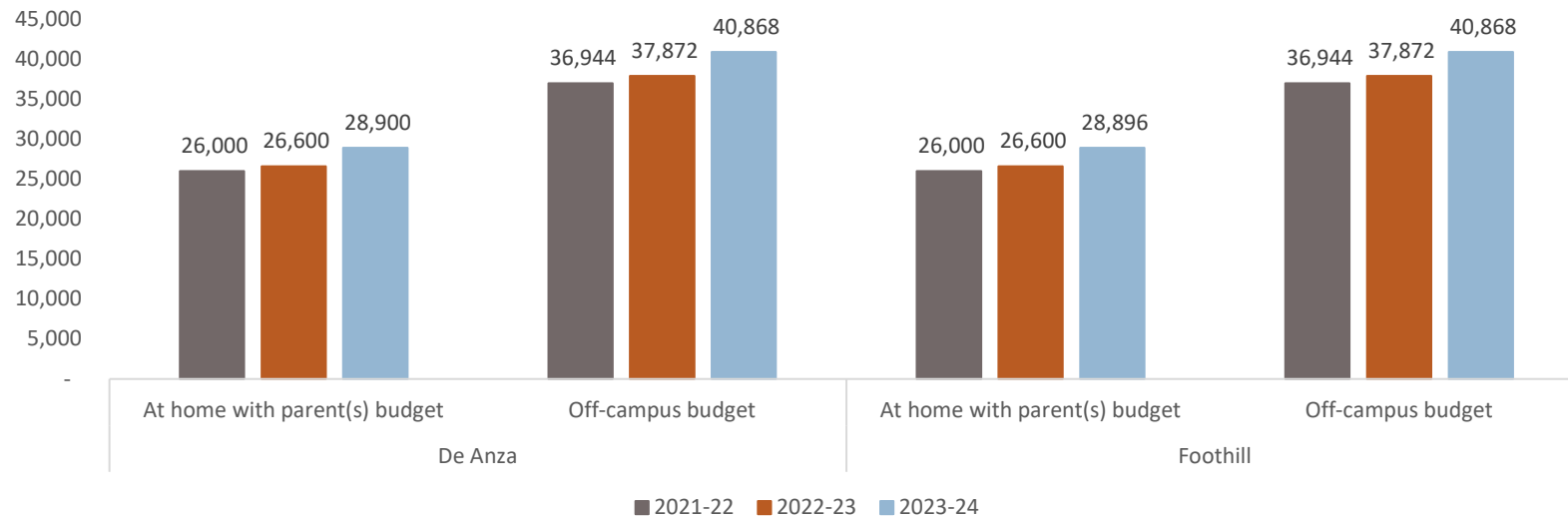

**SF04 Budget Amount: Median Amount by Budget Category, College and Academic Year**



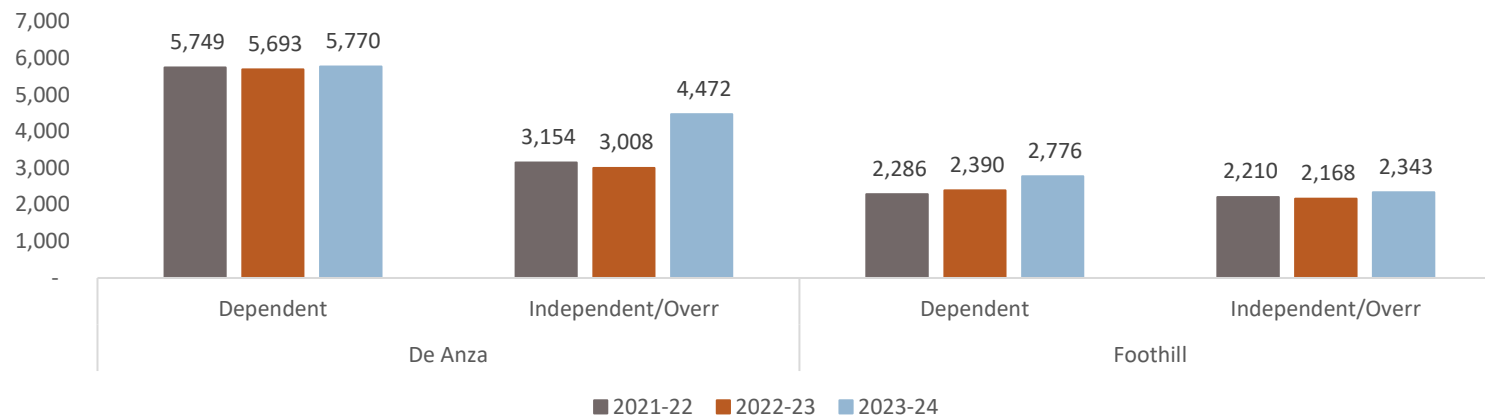

**SF05 Dependency-Status: Headcount by College and Academic Year**



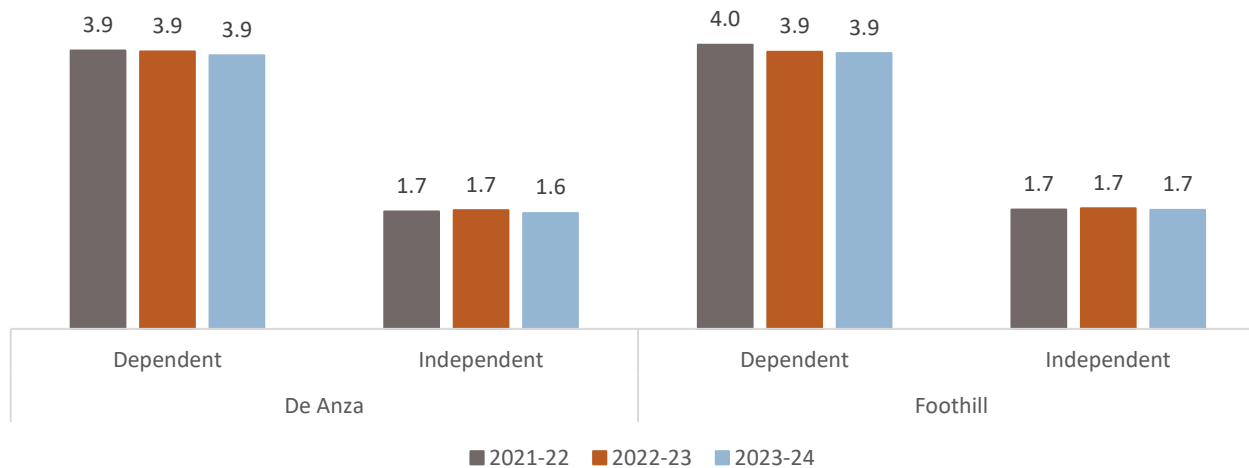

**SF06 Household-Size: Average by Dependency Status, College and Academic Year**





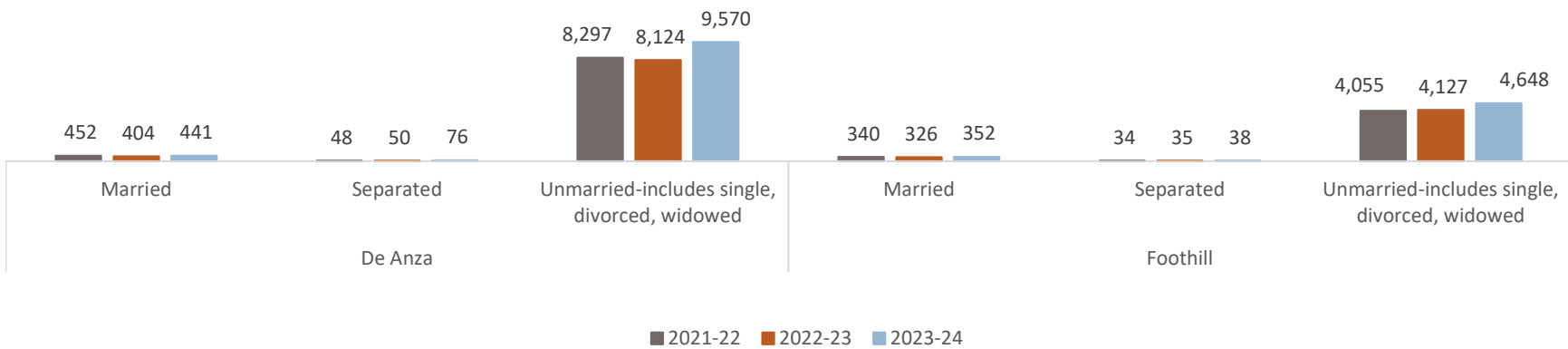

**SF06 Household-Size: Average by Dependency Status, College and Academic Year**



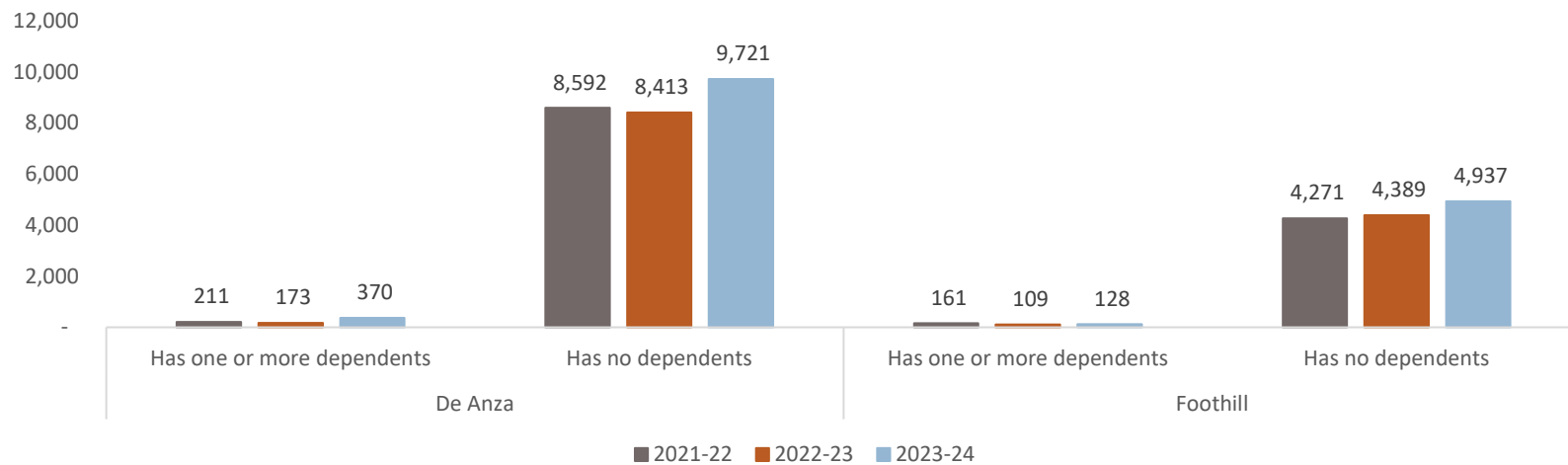
