

MIS Student Financial Aid Applicant (SF): Summary Statistics for 2024-25

## Introduction

The MIS Financial Aid reports –financial aid applicant (SF) and financial aid award (FA) – for the 2024-25 academic year were submitted to the CCCCO (California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office) by the FHDA CCD (Foothill-De Anza Community College District) on October 27, 2025. As part of data validation efforts, in this document we compare data in the MIS SF report for the last three academic years (i.e., 2022-23, 2023-24, 2024-25) to identify unexpected findings and whether these are due to data error or related issues. Data summarized here includes students' budget category and amount, dependency status, household size, marital status, number of dependents, income, and expected family contribution.

# **Data Issues**

Banner data used to derive the number of legal dependents for FAFSA applicants (Banner data field: RCRAPP1\_HAS\_LEGAL\_DEPEND) was missing for all 2024-25 records.

# **Data Highlights**

These are key findings shown in tables and figures at the end of this document.

- Data in Table 1 shows that the number of students who enrolled in at least one credit course at FHDA in 2024-25 dropped 1.1% (49,800 from 50,365) when compared to the prior academic year. Data disaggregated by college shows that the *credit student* headcount dropped 0.1% (28,588 from 28,622) at De Anza and 1.3% (24,151 from 24,477) at Foothill.
- Data in Table 2 shows that the number of FHDA students who received any type of financial aid or scholarship increased 7.6% (14,366 from 13,353) in 2024-25, compared to the prior academic year. At De Anza, the number increased 10.4% (10,031 from 9,086); at Foothill, 2.9% (5,200 from 5,055).

- Data for Foothill disaggregated by *budget status* (SF03) in Table 3 shows that in 2024-25 there was a significant increase in the number of students with an *at-home with parent(s)* budget, 35.4% (1,939 from 2,073), when compared to the academic prior year.
- Regarding changes in the last two academic years for the median budget amount (SF04), data in Table 4 shows about the same percentage increase across colleges for students living with parents, 9.5%, or those with an off-campus budget, 9.4%. In 2024-25 the median budget amount for FHDA students living with parents was about \$29,140; with an off-campus budget, \$41,440.
- Data disaggregated by dependency status (SF05) in Table 5 shows that the number of independent students at De Anza increased 49.3% (4,384 from 2,936) in 2024-25, compared to the number for the prior academic year. At Foothill, the number of dependent students increased 16.2% (2,778 from 2,390) during the same period.
- Data for household size (SF06) disaggregated by dependency status (SF05) in Table 6 shows that the 3-year average household size for dependent students was 3.8 and 3.9 at De Anza and Foothill, respectively; for independent students, 1.7 at both colleges.
- Data for *marital status* (SF07, position 1) in Table 7 shows that the percentage of financial aid students at Foothill who reported being *unmarried* increased 6.5 percentage points (88.1% from 81.6%) in 2024-25 over the prior academic year; at De Anza, 3.5 percentage points (93.0 from 89.4%).
- Data for *number of dependents* (SF07, position 2) in Table 8 shows that in 2024-25 the percentage of students reported as unknown was 97.3% and 98.1% at De Anza and Foothill, respectively. This was due to a data error issue in the Banner system (all records in 2024-25 had null in data source, RCRAPP1 HAS LEGAL DEPEND).
- Data in Table 9 shows that that median EFC (SF17, expected family contribution) in 2024-25 at both colleges was \$0, compared to \$2,835 and \$1,907 at De Anza and Foothill, respectively, for the previous academic year.

Student Headcount by Institution, Credit Status and Academic Year



MIS Student Financial Aid: Student Headcount by College and Academic Year



SF03 Budget Category: Headcount by College and Academic Year



SF04 Budget Amount: Median Amount by Budget Category, College and Academic Year



SF05 Dependency-Status: Headcount by College and Academic Year



SF06 Household-Size: Average by Dependency Status, College and Academic Year



SF07 Position 2, Number of Dependents for the Student: Headcount by College and Academic Year


