



MIS Student Financial Aid Applicant (SF): Summary Statistics for 2022-23

Introduction

The 2022-23 MIS Financial Aid reports –Applicant (SF) and Financial Award Type (FA) – were submitted by the FHDA CCD (Foothill-De Anza Community College District) to the CCCCO (California Community Colleges Chancellor’s Office) on December 29, 2023. This document shows summary statistics for the MIS SF report and compare the data with that submitted in the last two prior academic years (i.e., 2020-21 and 2021-22).

Data Highlights

These are key findings shown in tables at the end of this document.

- The number of students who enrolled in at least one credit course at FHDA in 2022-23 stayed relatively the same in 2022-23, compared to the prior academic year, as shown by data in Table 1. Data disaggregated by college show that between 2021-22 and 2022-23 the student headcount for credit courses at De Anza drop 1.0% (minus 261), while at Foothill it increased 0.5% (plus 116).
- Data in Table 2 show that the number of Foothill students who received any type of financial aid dropped 5.0% in 2022-23 (minus 226), compared to the prior academic year. At De Anza, the number of students with financial aid dropped 0.9% (minus 85) during the same period.
- Data disaggregated by *budget status* (SF03) in Table 3 show that the number of financial aid students living with parents dropped at a higher rate in 2022-23 than those not living with parents (i.e., off-campus budget), compared to the prior academic year. At De Anza, the number dropped 3.0% (minus 149); at Foothill, 5.4% (minus 96). In 2022-23, the percentage of financial aid students with a known budget that reported living with their parents was 56.7% and 42.4% at De Anza and Foothill, respectively.

- Data in Table 4 show that in 2022-23 the median *budget amount* (SF04) increased 2.3% over the prior academic year for students living with parents, and 2.5% for those not living with parents. On average, the median budget amount for Foothill students increased 2.5%; for De Anza students, 2.3%.
- Data disaggregated by *dependency status* (SF05) in Table 5 show that in 2022-23 the number of dependent students increased 4.5% (plus 104) at Foothill over the prior year, while at De Anza their number dropped 1.0% (minus 56). The headcount for independent students dropped at both colleges: 1.7% (minus 36) at Foothill and 5% (minus 154) at De Anza.
- Data for *household size* (SF06) disaggregated by *dependency status* (SF05) in Table 6 show that in 2022-23 the average household size for dependent students was 3.9 and 4.0 at De Anza and Foothill, respectively. For independent students, the average household size 1.7 at both colleges.
- Data for *marital status* (SF07, position 1) in Table 7 show that in 2022-23 the number of financial aid students who reported being married dropped 10.6% (minus 48) and 4.1% (minus 14) at De Anza and Foothill, respectively, over the prior year. Among financial aid students who reported marital status in 2022-23, the percentage of married students was 4.7% and 7.3% at De Anza and Foothill, respectively.
- Data for *number of dependents* (SF07, position 2) in Table 8 show that in 2022-23 the number of financial aid students with at least one dependent dropped 32.3% (minus 52) and 18.0% (minus 38) at Foothill and De Anza, respectively, when compared to the prior academic year. Among students with data for number of dependents, the percentage of students with at least one dependent in 2022-23 was 2.4% and 2.0% at Foothill and De Anza, respectively.
- Data in Figure 9 show that median expected family contribution (EFC, SF17) in 2022-23 increased 5.4% (plus \$145) at De Anza over the prior academic year. At Foothill, the EFC dropped 19.0% (minus \$448).

Student Headcount by Institution, Credit Status and Academic Year

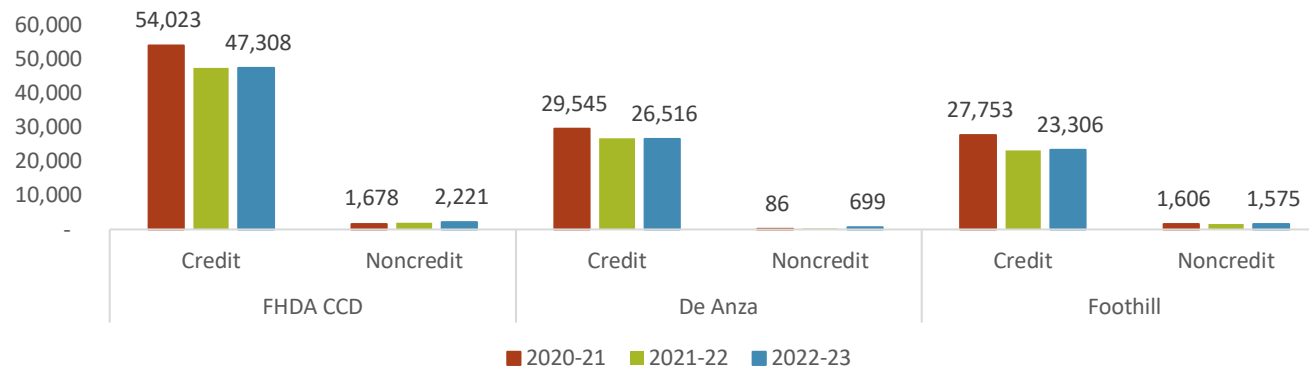

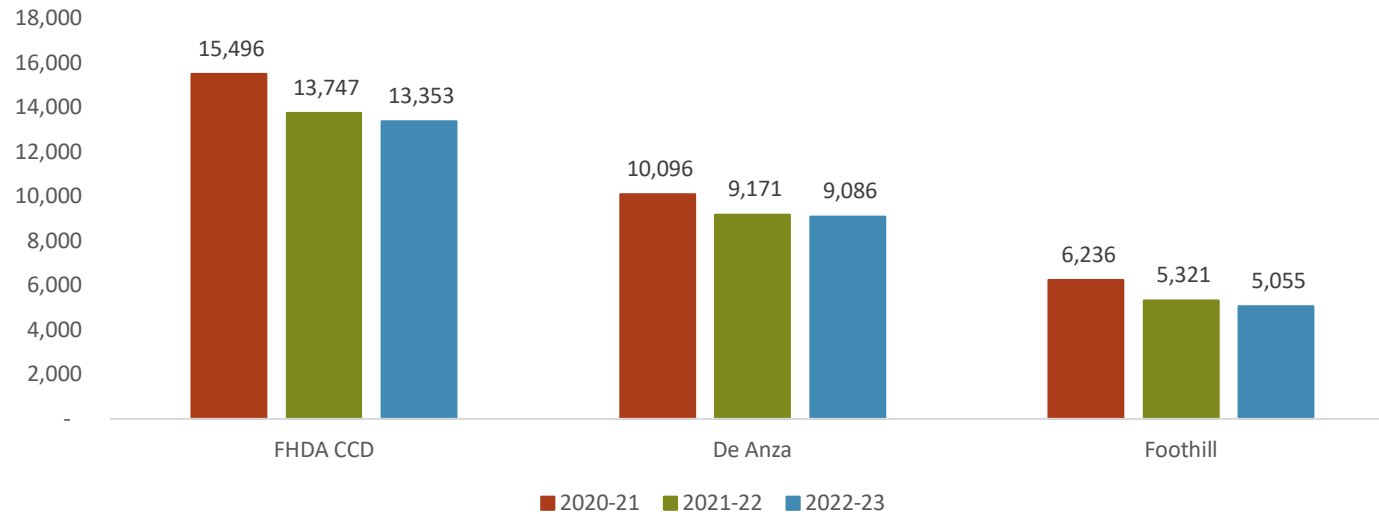
Figure 2**MIS Student Financial Aid: Student Headcount by College and Academic Year**

SF03 Budget Category: Headcount by College and Academic Year

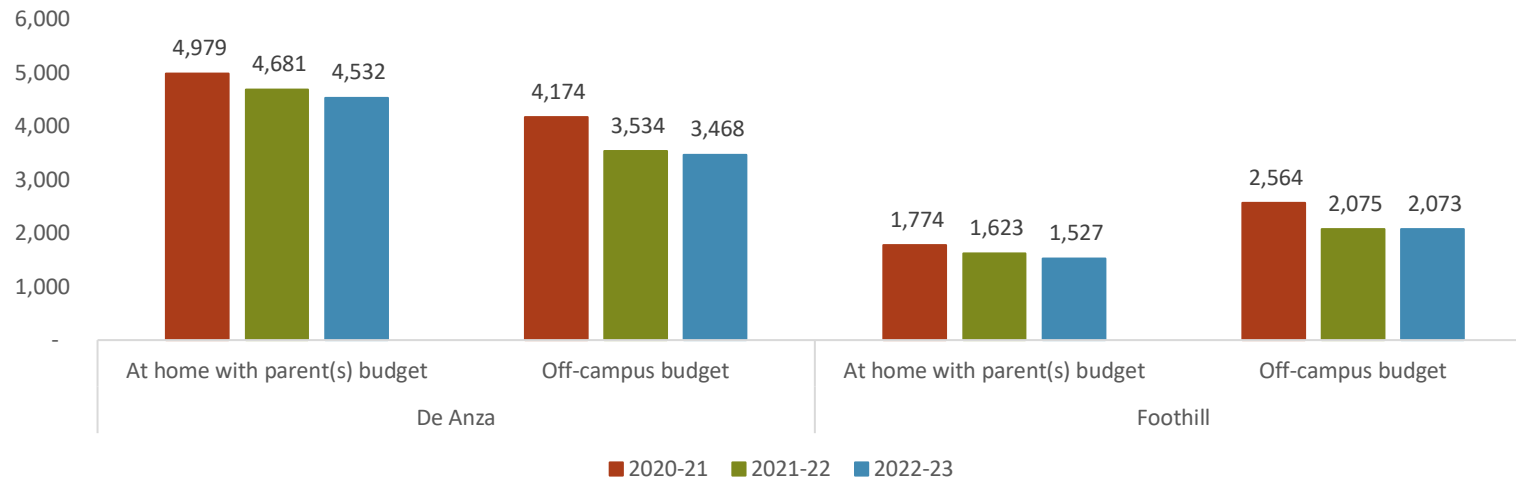

SF04 Budget Amount: Median Amount by Budget Category, College and Academic Year

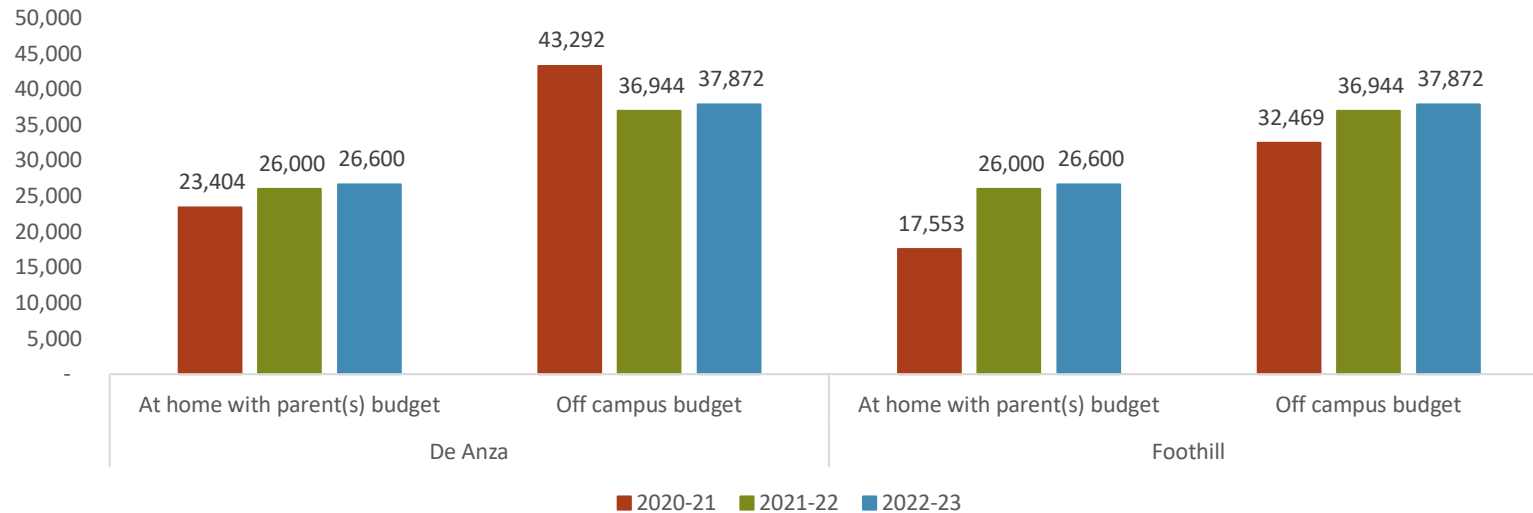

SF05 Dependency-Status: Headcount by College and Academic Year

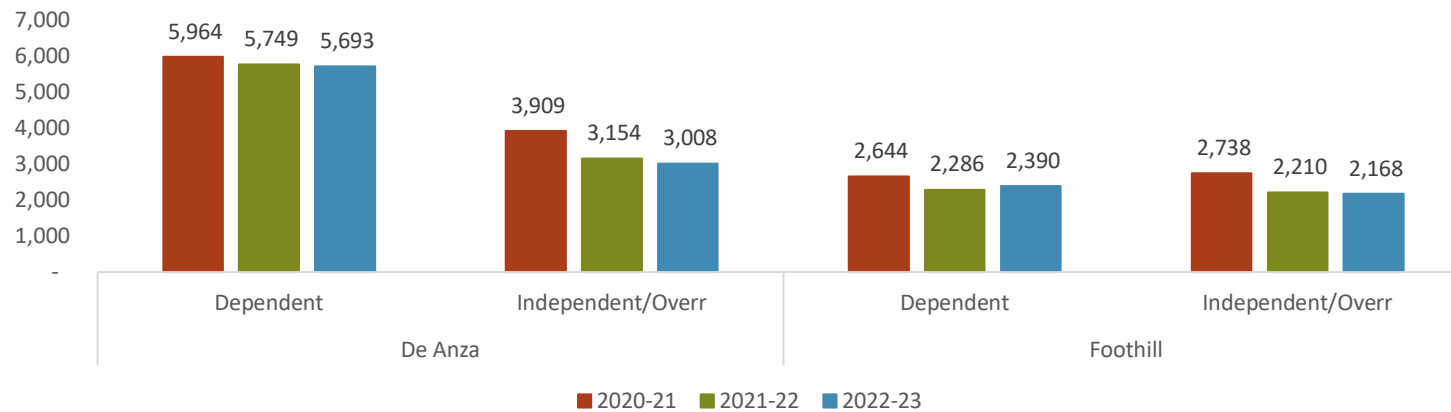

SF06 Household-Size: Average by Dependency Status, College and Academic Year

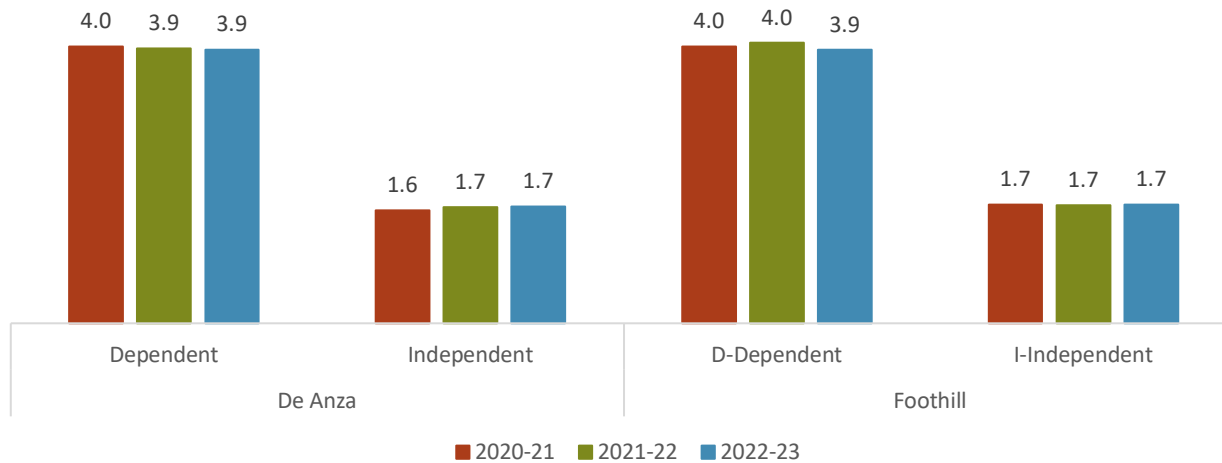

SF06 Household-Size: Average by Dependency Status, College and Academic Year

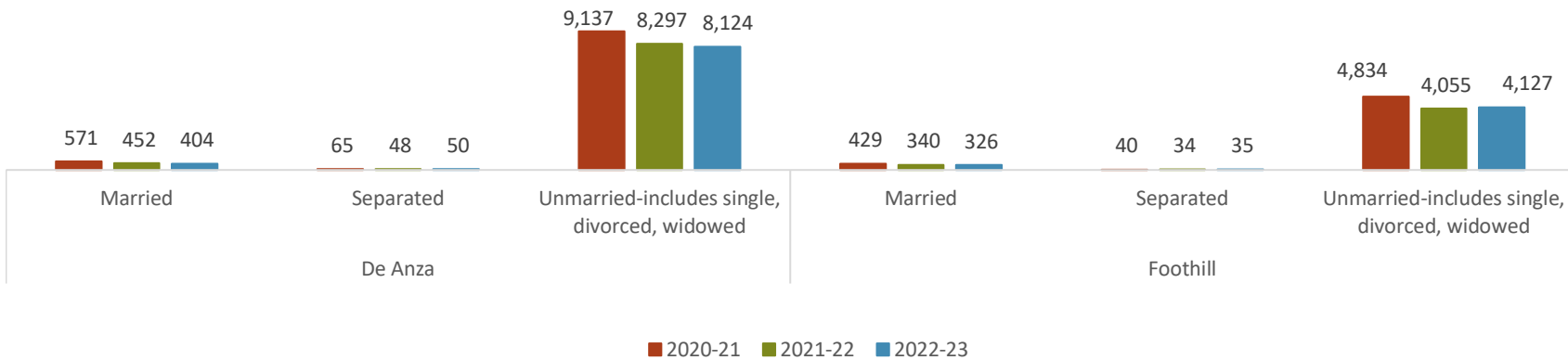

SF07 Position 2, Number of Dependents for the Student: Headcount by College and Academic Year

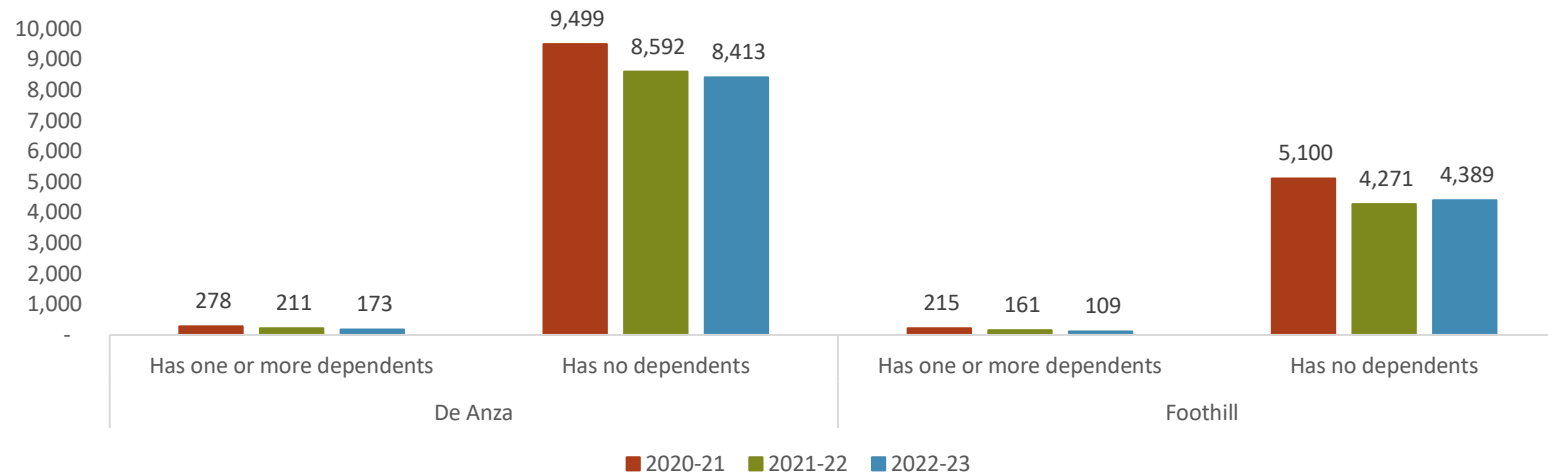
