

## FHDA MIS Quarterly Submission Report

Reporting term: spring 2024

Data extraction (Banner production) and submission/resubmission dates:

July 16 (summer resubmission); July 17 (fall resubmission); July 18 (winter resubmission); and July 26 (spring submission).

### Introduction

The MIS quarterly reports for the 2023-24 academic year were submitted by the FHDA CCD (Foothill-De Anza Community College District) to the CCCCO (California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office) on July 2024. The purpose of this document is to document threats to the validity of the data submitted in these reports and highlight key findings.

In addition to documenting data quality issues not yet resolved by the date of submission, this document provides tables with statistics on student characteristics, course offerings and faculty instructional workload for the spring term and compare these with those for the same term of the prior academic year.

Annual student headcount by student characteristics and special population group for the last two academic years are shown in this document; annual FTES (student full time equivalent) statistics by course credit status are also included.

More information on the data submitted is available at the CCCCO MIS data mart, <https://datamart.cccco.edu/DataMart.aspx>. This website provides data on students, courses, services, outcomes and employees within the entire CCCCO system that can be disaggregated by state, district, college, and academic period.

This document is divided into three sections:

- Section A. *Data quality issues*: documents problems or errors with the data
- Section B. *Data highlights*: provides a summary of key findings
- Section C. *Tables*: shows data for the reporting term/academic year and the corresponding previous academic period. Significant or unexpected changes are highlighted (i.e., shows a trend by comparing the statistics for the group with for the college or total)

## Section A. Data Quality Issues

The following data quality issues were still unresolved by the date of submission.

### De Anza College

- SB Student Characteristics
  - Missing data on race/ethnicity
    - Data disaggregated by *residency status* in Table A.1 show that 59.3% of *international students* in 2023-24 had “Not reported” as race/ethnicity, compared to 50.6% during the previous academic year. Given that the majority of *international students* tend to be Asian (see Table A.2), these findings suggest an undercount for this race/ethnic group students at the college level.
- SY Credit for Prior Learning
  - Less than 1% (2 out of 267) of all records for spring 2024 were rejected because of discrepancies between units awarded/transferred and those approved for the course—the number of units transferred were higher than the number approved for the course.

## Foothill College

- SB Student Characteristics
  - Data disaggregated by *residency status* in Table A.1 show that 30.1% of *international students* in 2023-24 had “Not reported” as race/ethnicity, compared to 28.9% during the previous academic year. Given that the majority of *international students* tend to be Asian (see Table A.2), these findings suggest an undercount for this race/ethnic group students at the college level.
- SX Enrollment
  - Data in Table A.3 show that 259 enrollment records in 2023-24 were reported with ‘RD’ (report delayed/missing grade) as final grade; 204 (78.8%) of these were for CTE (Career Technical Education) courses. Data in Table A.4 shows that 15 of the 19 sections with no final grade data (100% ‘RD’) were from the *American Aerospace Technical Academy* (AATA) department.
  - Data for 2023-24 in Table A.6 shows 579 enrollment records missing positive attendance; 419 (72.4%) of these were for CTE courses. See Table A.7 for details.
- SY Credit for Prior Learning
  - More than 80% (54 of 66) of all records for spring 2024 were rejected because of discrepancies between the number of units awarded/transferred and the units approved for the course: 66.7% (44) had lower units than those approved, and 15.2% (10) had higher units.

## Section B. Data Highlights

### Students Characteristics, Spring 2024

- Data in Table SB.1 show that the number of students at De Anza increased 6.8% (15,539 from 14,548) in spring 2024 when compared to the prior spring term. In Table SB.2 statistics show that the number of students enrolled in *only noncredit* courses increased 31.8% (456 from 346). Data in Table SB.3 show that in the last two spring terms less than 1% of De Anza students at enrolled in *apprenticeship* courses: 15 in spring 2023; 10 in spring 2024.
- For Foothill, data in Table SB.1 show an increase of 2.6% (11,303 from 11,019) in the student headcount for spring 2024 when compared to spring 2023. Data in Table SB.2 show that the number of students enrolled in at least one credit course increased 3.8% (10,619 from 10,235) while the number for those enrolled in *only noncredit* courses fell 12.8% (684 from 784). When excluding students enrolled in *apprenticeship* courses, data in Table SB.3 shows that the headcount for students enrolled in credit courses at Foothill increased 5.6% (9,987 from 9,460).
- Data in Table SB.3 show that the student headcount for *apprenticeship* courses at Foothill fell 18.8% in spring 2024, compared to the prior spring term. However, data for missing positive attendance in Table A.6 suggests that the student headcount for *apprenticeship* courses may increase to some extent once all data is reported.
- Data in Table SB.4 show that the number of *international* students at De Anza and Foothill increased 27.6% (1,291 from 1,012) and 10.4% (479 from 434), respectively, in spring 2024 when compared to the prior spring term.
- Headcount data by *gender* in Table SB.5 show that the number of male students at De Anza increased 7.7% (7,761 from 7,203) during the last two spring terms. Male students accounted for 49.9% of the total headcount in spring 2024 at De Anza; females, 47.9%.
- De Anza data disaggregated by *race/ethnicity* in Table SB.6 show a higher-than-expected increase in the number of *White* students: 19.9% (3,004 from 2,506). Data for Foothill show that the number of *Asian* students increased 11.2% (3,405 from 3,062) while the number of *White* students fell 5% (2,926 from 3,081) during the same period.
- Data disaggregated by *age* group in Table SB.7 show that the number of De Anza students aged *30 or older* increased 26.3% (3,530 from 2,794). At Foothill, the number of students *younger than 25* increased 8.3% (6,823 from 6,301) while the number for those *25 or older* fell 5.1% (4,471 from 4,712).
- Data for *credit load* (i.e., number of credit units registered during the term) in Table SB.8 show a higher-than-expected increase at both colleges in the number of students in the *6 to 11.5* and *more than 15 units* groups. For the *6 to 11.5* group, De Anza data shows an increase of 9.8% (3,684 from 3,354) in headcount; Foothill, 10.4% (2,706 from 2,451). For the *more than 15 units* group, the percentage increase at De Anza was 11.5% (2,824 from 2,532); at Foothill, 24.3% (1,265 from 1,018).

## Categorical Programs/Special Populations, Spring 2024

- Data for *categorical programs* (i.e., DSPS, EOPS, CalWORKs) at De Anza in Table SG.1 show that the student headcount for CalWORKs and DSPS increased 53.3% (46 from 30) and 16.4% (959 from 824), respectively, in spring 2024 when compared to the prior spring term. The headcount for EOPS fell 15.2% (390 from 460) during the same period.
- Data in Table SG.2 for *categorical programs* at Foothill show that between the last two spring terms the headcount for CalWORKs and EOPS increased 80% (9 from 5) and 30.4% (219 from 168), respectively. The headcount for DSPS fell 8.5% (674 from 737).
- Data for *special population* groups at De Anza in Table SG.1 show a higher-than-expected increase in the headcount for *Puente* (28.6%; 63 from 49). The headcount for *Umoja* fell 7.7% (48 from 52).
- Foothill data in Table SG.2 show a higher-than-expected increase between the last two spring terms for the *Basic Needs Center* (242.3%; 1,116 from 326), CCAP (5.3%, 415 from 394), *Puente* (6.9%, 62 from 58) and *Umoja* (23.6%, 68 from 55).

## VTEA/Perkins, Spring 2024

- Data in Table SV.1 show that the number of students classified as *economically disadvantaged* who enrolled in *CTE (Career Technical Education)* courses at De Anza increased 9.2% (2,872 from 2,631) in spring 2024 when compared to the headcount in spring 2023. At Foothill, the data show that the number of *economically disadvantaged* CTE student fell 2.0% (1,435 from 1,464) during this period.

## Students Characteristics, 2023-24 Academic Year

- Data in Table SB.A1 show that student headcount at De Anza increased 8.5% (29,525 from 27,208) in 2024-23 over the prior academic year. Statistics in Table SB.A2 show that the number of students enrolled in *only noncredit* courses increased 29.9% (907 from 698) during this period. In Table SB.A3 the data show that during the last two academic years less than 1% of the college student population enrolled in *apprenticeship* courses: 28 in 2022-23; 32 in 2023-24.
- For Foothill, data in Table SB.A1 show an increase of 2.7% (25,527 from 24,855) in the student headcount in 2023-24 when compared the prior academic year. Data in Table SB.2 show that the number of students enrolled in at least one credit course increased 4.9% (24,437 from 23,298) while the number for those enrolled in *only noncredit* courses fell 30% (1,090 from 1,557). When excluding students enrolled in *apprenticeship* courses, data in Table SB.3 shows that the number of students who enrolled in credit courses at Foothill increased 6.6% (22,202 from 20,828) during this period.
- Data in Table SB.A3 show that the headcount for students taking only *apprenticeship* courses at Foothill fell 9.3% (2,231 from 2,461) in 2023-24.

However, data for missing positive attendance in Table A.6 suggests that the student headcount for apprenticeship courses may increase once all the data is reported.

- Data disaggregated by *enrollment* status (based on the first term of the academic year when the student enrolled at the college) in Table SB.A1 show that the headcount for *first-time transfer* students increased at both colleges in 2023-24 over the prior academic year: De Anza, 25.6% (7,576 from 6,034); Foothill, 6.4% (8,581 from 8,068). The headcount for *special admit* students also grew significantly at Foothill during this period, 5.1% (3,629 from 3,453).
- Data in SB.A4 show that the number of *international* students increased 22.8% (1,653 from 1,346) at De Anza in 2023-24 when compared to the prior academic year.
- Headcount data by *gender* in Table SB.A5 show that the number of male students at De Anza increased 11.5% (14,492 from 13,002) between the last two academic years. Male students accounted for 49.1% of the total headcount in 2023-24; females, 48.9%.
- De Anza data disaggregated by *race/ethnicity* in Table SB.A6 show a higher-than-expected increase in the number of *White* students (29.5%; 5,911 from 4 696) in 2023-24, compared to the prior academic year. The number of student missing race/ethnicity data (“Not reported”) at De Anza increased 37.2% (1,437 from 1,083). By the end of 2024-23, *Asian*, *Hispanic*, and *White* students accounted for 42.8%, 24%, and 20%, respectively, of the total student headcount at De Anza.
- Data for Foothill in Table SB.A6 show that the number of *Asian* students increased 5.9% (7,772 from 7,341) between the last two academic years. *Asian*, *Hispanic*, and *White* students accounted for 30.4%, 28.4%, and 27.1%, respectively, of the total student headcount at Foothill in 2023-24.
- Data for De Anza disaggregated by *age* group in Table SB.A7 show that the number of students aged *30 or older* increased 32% (7,151 from 5,417). At Foothill, the number of students *19 or younger* increased 7% (8,449 from 7,896) while the number for those *40 or older* fell 10.4% (3,684 from 3,333).
- Data for *credit load* (i.e., number of credit units registered during the academic year) in Table SB.A8 show a higher-than-expected increase at De Anza in the number of students who enrolled in *6 to 12.5* units (18.3%; 5, 800 from 4,902) during 2023-24 when compared to the previous academic year. At Foothill, the number of students who enrolled in *13 or more* units during the academic year increased 9.2% (9,132 from 8,365) during the same period.



### Categorical Programs/Special Populations, 2023-24 Academic Year

- Data for *categorical programs* (i.e., DSPS, EOPS, CalWORKs) at De Anza in Table SG.1 show that the annual headcount for CalWORKs increased 18.5% (64 from 54) in 2023-24, compared to 2022-23. The annual headcount for EOPS fell 18.4% (485 from 594) during the same period.
- Data in Table SG.2 for *categorical programs* at Foothill College show that between the last two academic years the headcount for CalWORKs doubled (14 from 7). During the same period, the annual headcount for EOPS increased 27% (296 from 233); for DSPS, it fell 1.6% (1,262 from 1,283).
- Foothill data in Table SG.2 show a higher-than-expected increase between the last two academic years in the annual headcount for the following programs: *Basic Needs Center* (92.9%; 1,570 from 814), CCAP (28.5%; 1,729 from 1,346), Puente (8%, 81 from 75) and Umoja (17.9%, 72 from 78).

### VTEA/Perkins, 2023-24 Academic Year

- Data in Table SV.A1 show that between 2023-24 and 2022-23 the annual headcount for students classified as *economically disadvantaged* who enrolled in CTE (*Career Technical Education*) courses increased 15.6% (6,058 from 5,240) at De Anza and 6.7% (3,560 from 3,337) at Foothill.

### Student Success, 2023-24 Academic Year

- Data in Table SS.A1 and SS.A2 show that the headcount for students who received *at-risk* (academic probation) services fell significantly at both colleges in 2023-24 when compared to the prior academic year: De Anza, 48.5% (2,662 from 5,167); Foothill, 36.6% (484 from 764).
- Data for Foothill in Table in SS.A2 show a higher-than-expected increase in the annual headcount across students services in 2023-24, compared to 2022-23, excluding at-risk (academic probation) services.

## FTES (Full Time Equivalent Student), 2023-24 Academic Year

- Data in Table SX.A1 show that the FTES for *credit* courses at De Anza increased 5.7% (14,662.63 from 13,872.79) in 2023-24 when compared 2022-23. The FTES for *international* students in this table show an increase of 28.2% (1,419.22 from 1,107.08); for *no apprenticeship-California residents* the data show an increase of 3.8% (12,910.65 from 12,432.24).
- For *noncredit* courses at De Anza, data in Table SX.A2 show an increase in FTES of 32.9% (325.75 from 245.05), with *CDCP: English as a Second Language* courses showing the largest increase: 39.3% (193.02 from 138.53).
- For Foothill, data in Table SX.A3 show that the FTES for *credit* courses increased 8.1% (9,694.67 from 8,970.06) between 2022-23 and 2023-24. The FTES for *no apprenticeship-California residents* increased 9.5% (8,108.31 from 7,403.95); for *international* students, 14.8% (486.47 from 423.61).
- FTES data for *noncredit* courses at Foothill in Table SX.A4 show an increase of 12.4% (289.18 from 257.38) between the last two academic years. The data show that the FTES for *CDCP: Short-Term Vocational* courses increased 73.5% (66.64 from 38.41) and for *CDCP: Elementary and Secondary Basic Skills*, 24.6% (77.13 from 61.90).

## Section C. Tables

The tables shown in this section are designed to help data custodians review the data submitted. The column “Trend” is meant to help them identify unexpected changes in the data for a given group (e.g., group of students or courses) after considering changes at the college level. A green upwards arrow is used to signal that the change is positive (i.e., greater than zero) and higher than that for the college (i.e., the group outperformed when compared to the college population by at least one percentage point). The red downward arrow is used to signal that the change is negative (i.e., lower than zero) and lower than that for the college (e.g., the group underperformed when compared to the college population by at least one percentage point). Data custodians are encouraged to assess whether these changes are the product of data validity issues or other unrelated factors (e.g., a statistical artifact due to a small cell size with a large percentage change).

Excluding data for *categorical programs*, *special populations* and *student success* (3SP) statistics; headcounts only include students who were enrolled by census date or have attended one class with positive attendance, as applicable. Some tables, as

noted, use an alternative headcount method to calculate headcounts (e.g., at least one course enrollment by census date or applicable to apportionment, independently of positive attendance).

Course/section data include only classes with at least one student enrolled by census date and no data error by the time of submission (i.e., not rejected by the MIS system).

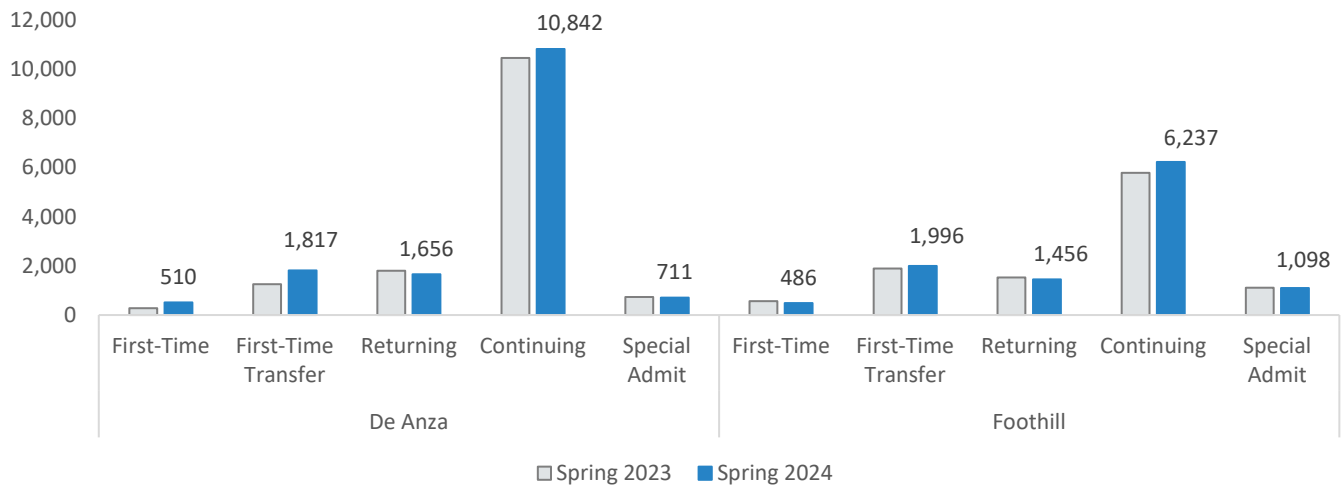

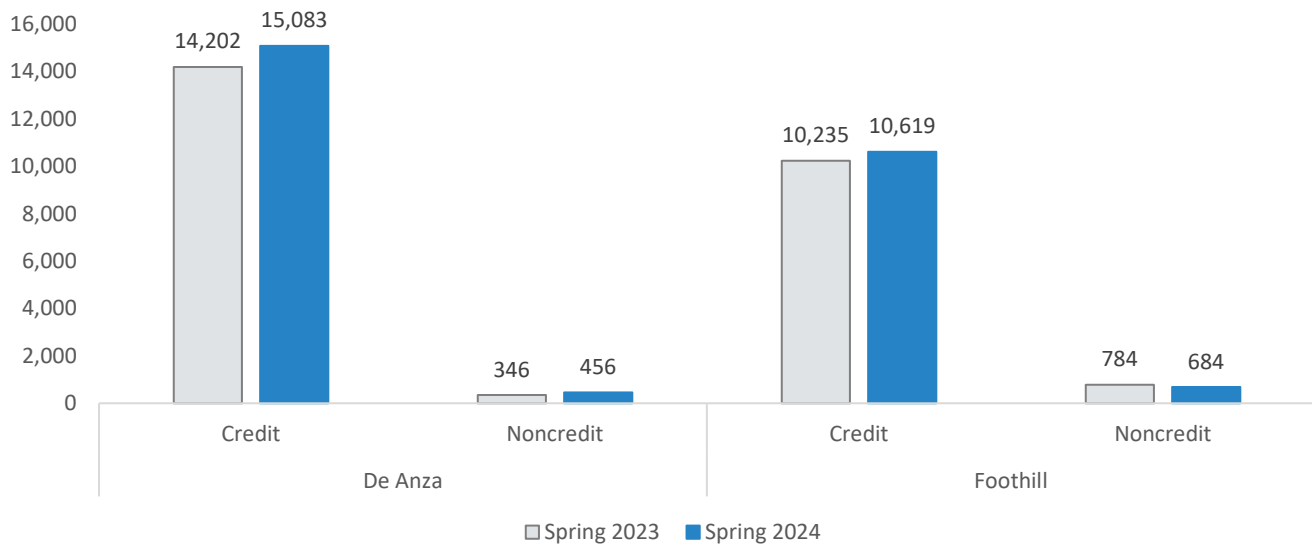

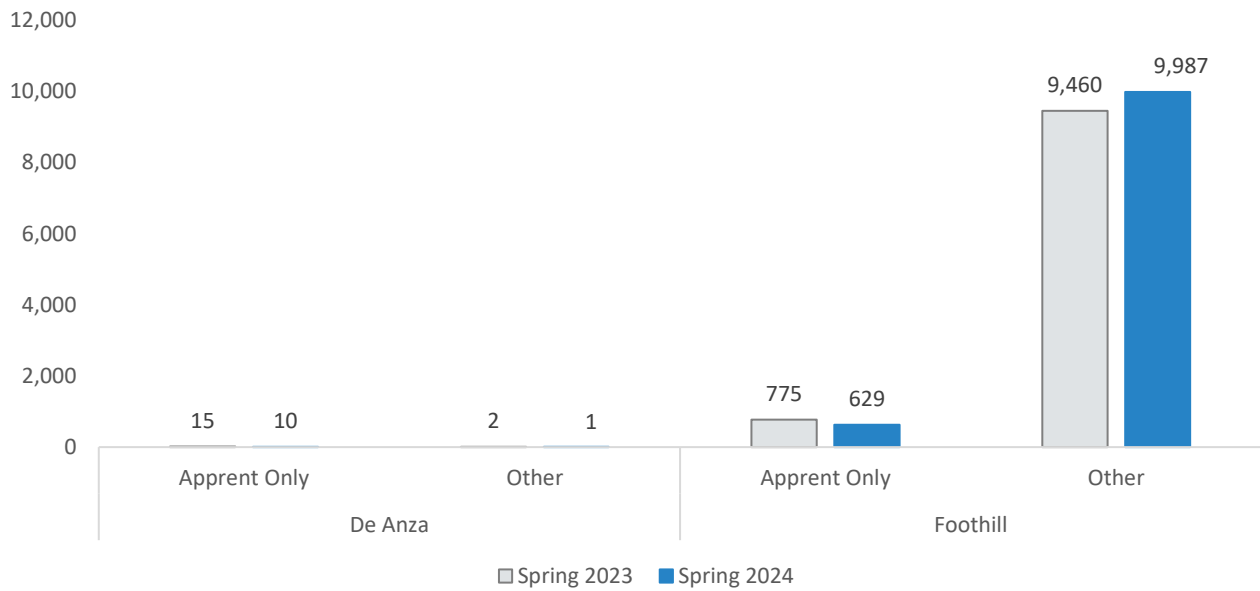

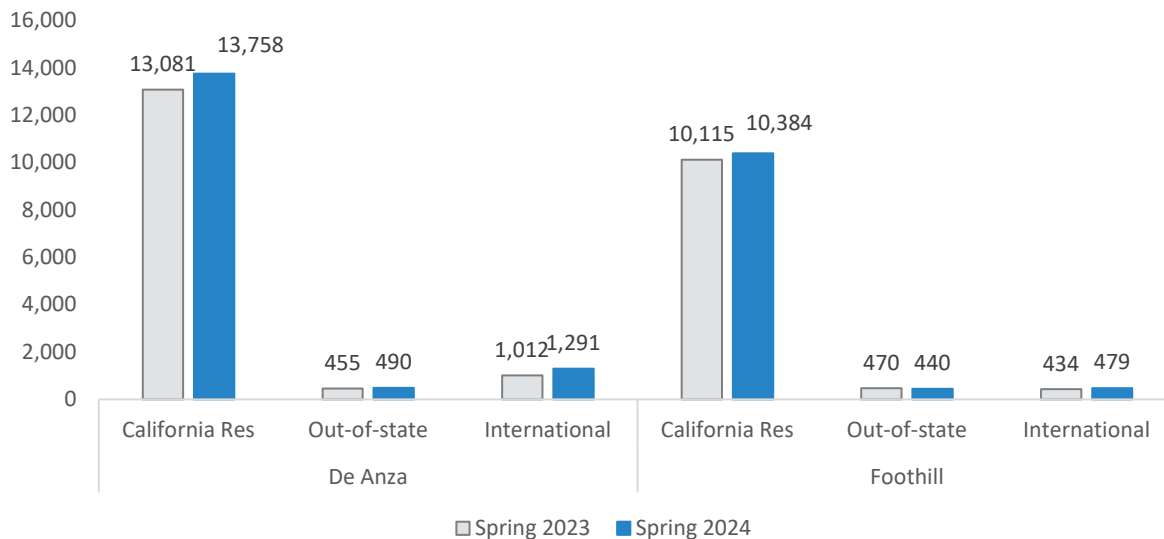

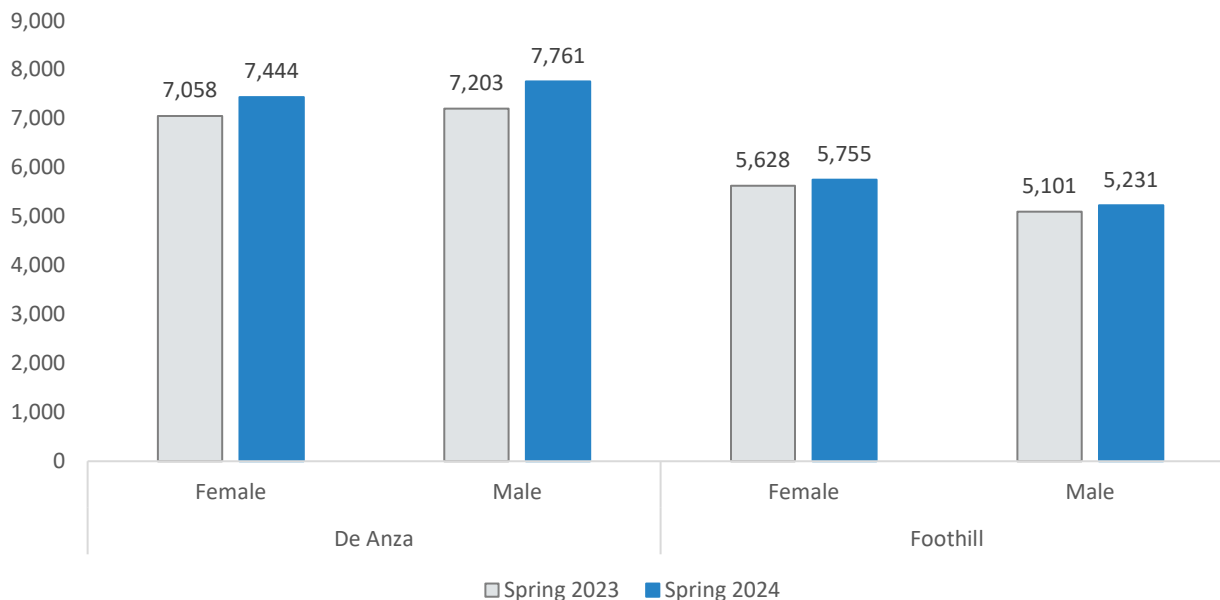

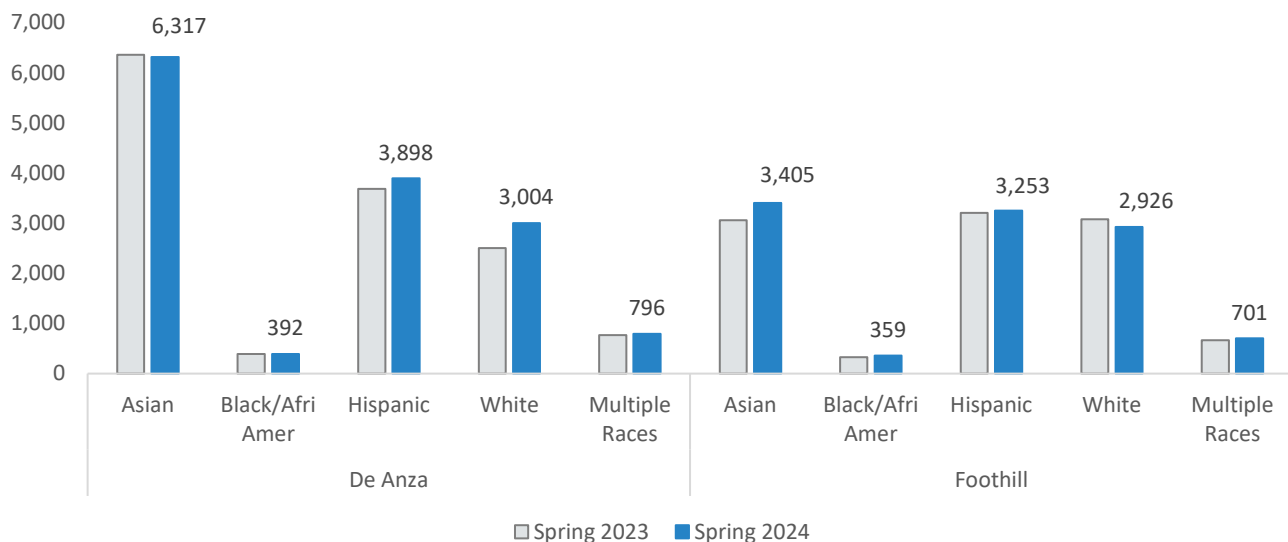

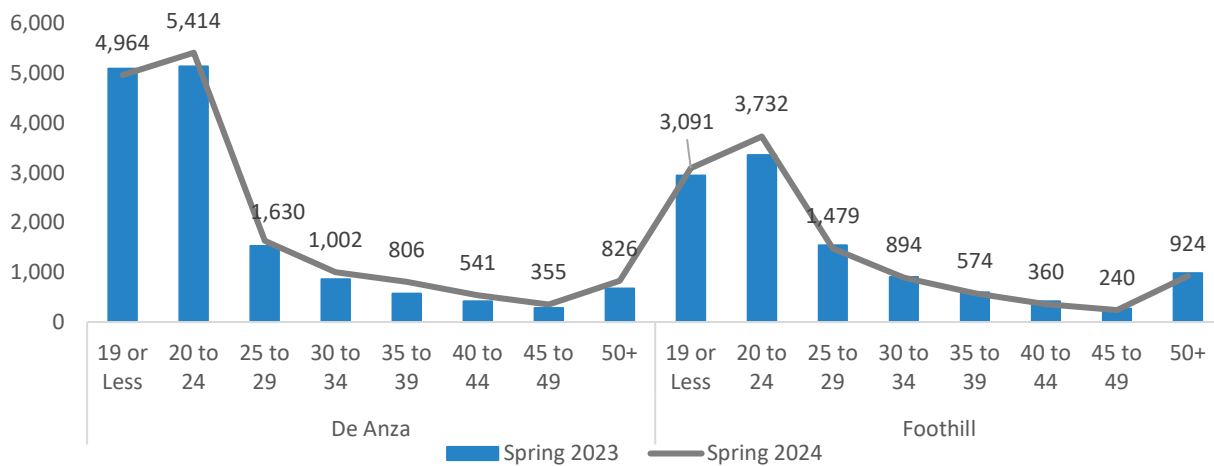

**Figure SB.7 Student Headcount by College, Age Group and Academic Period**



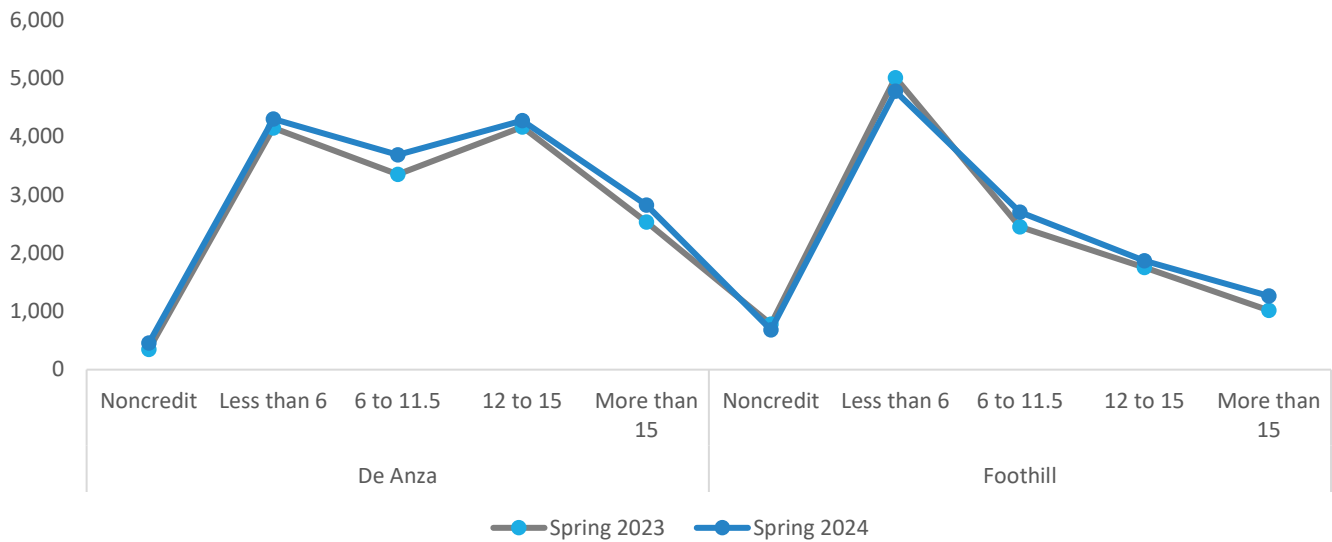

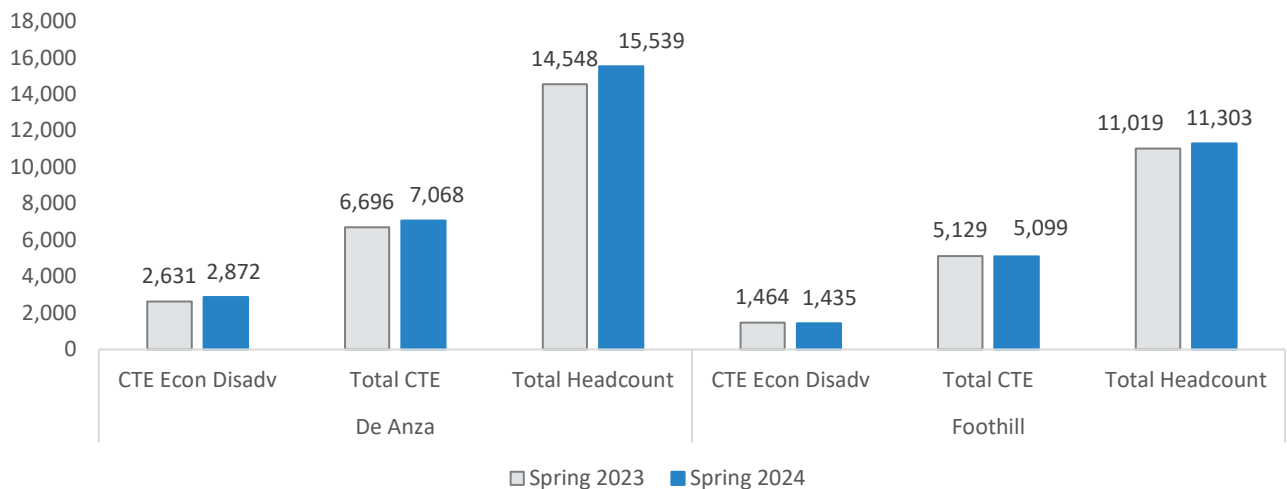

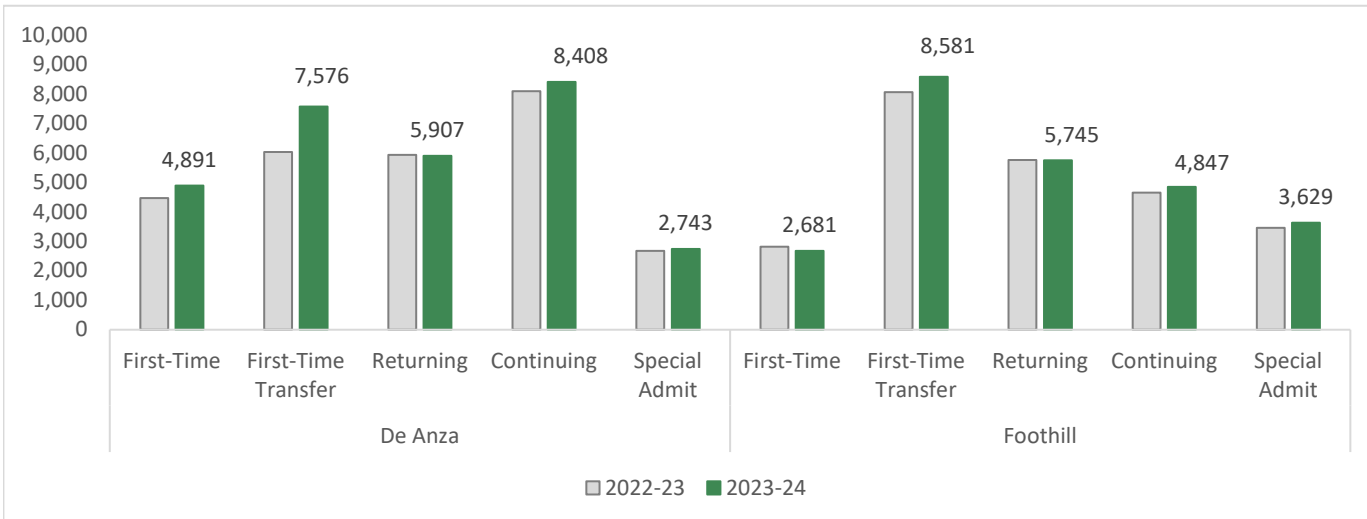

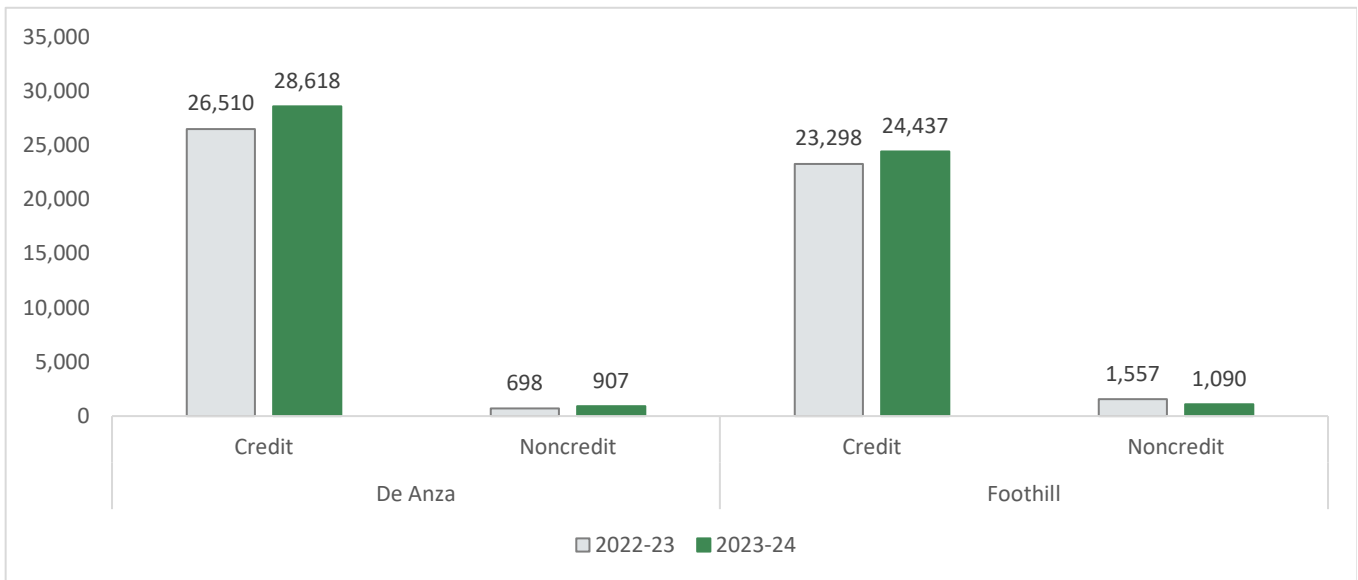

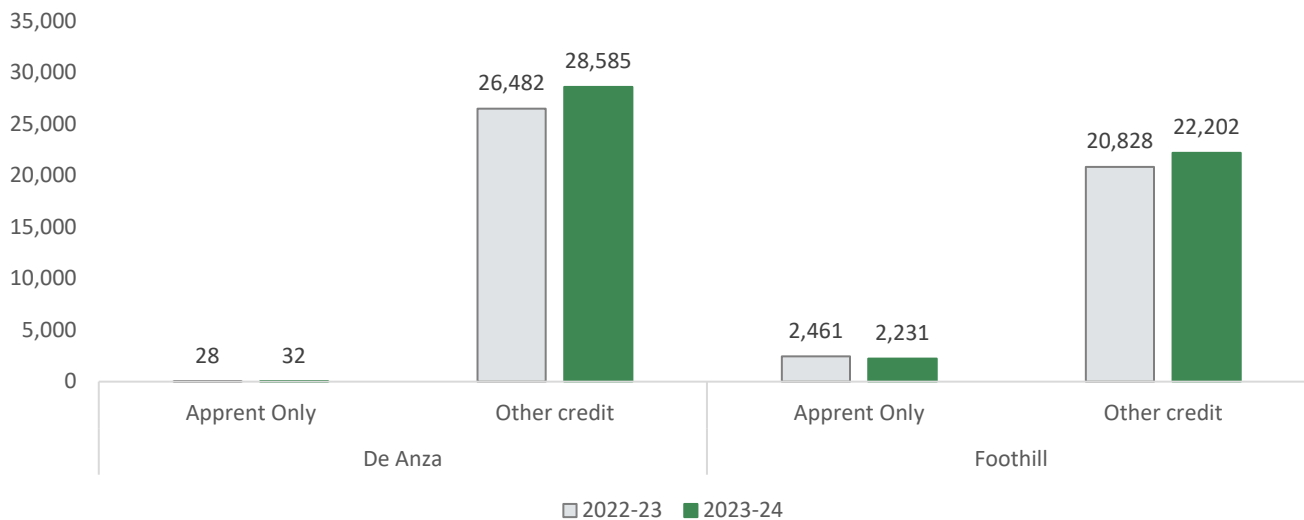

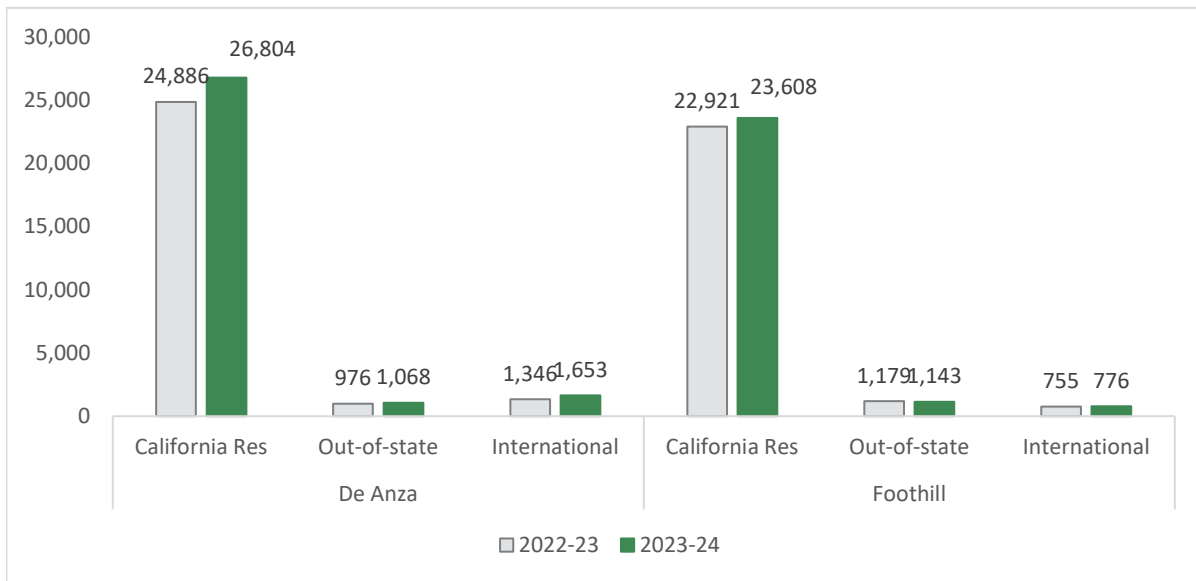

**Figure SB.A4 Student Headcount by College, Residency Status and Academic Period**



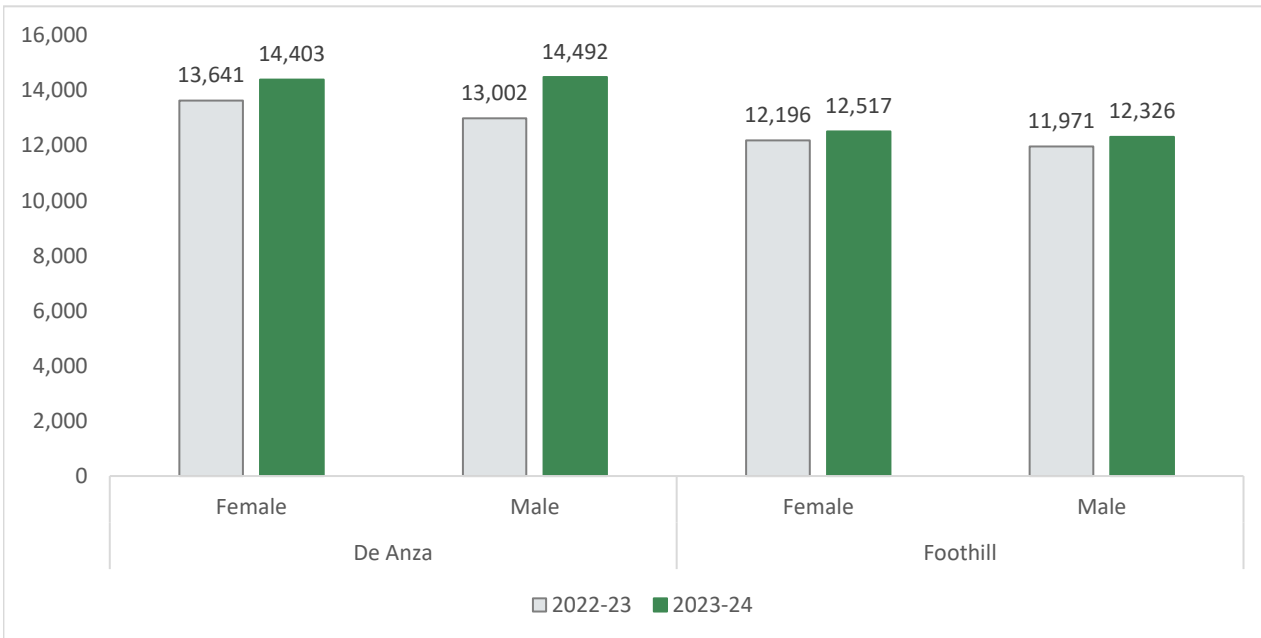

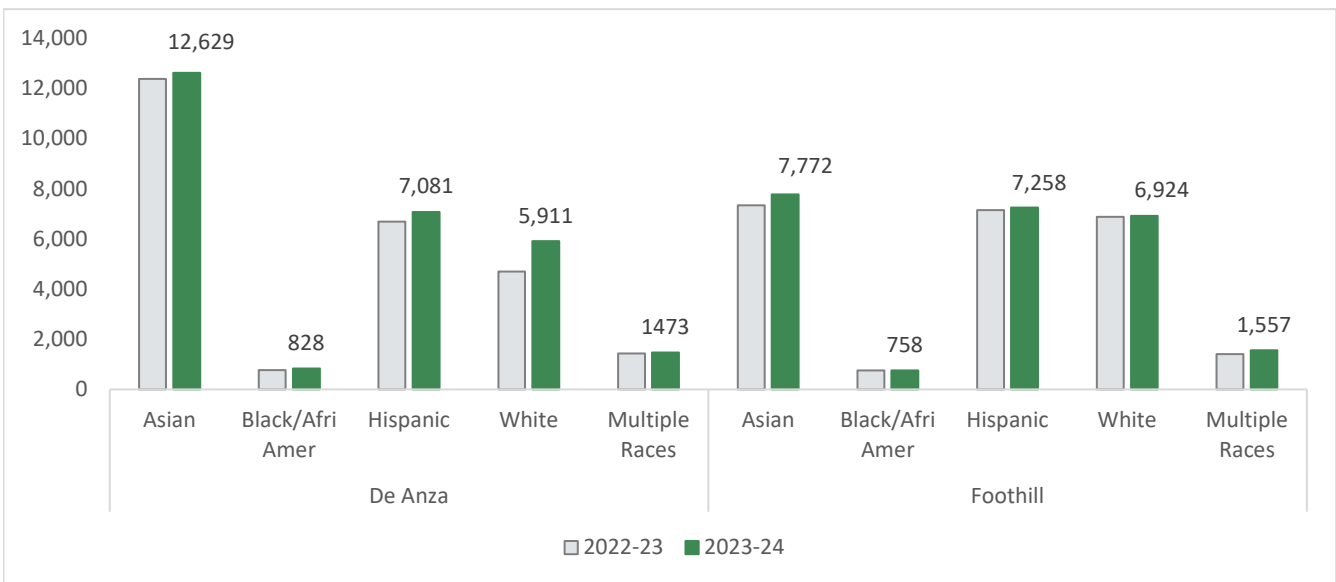

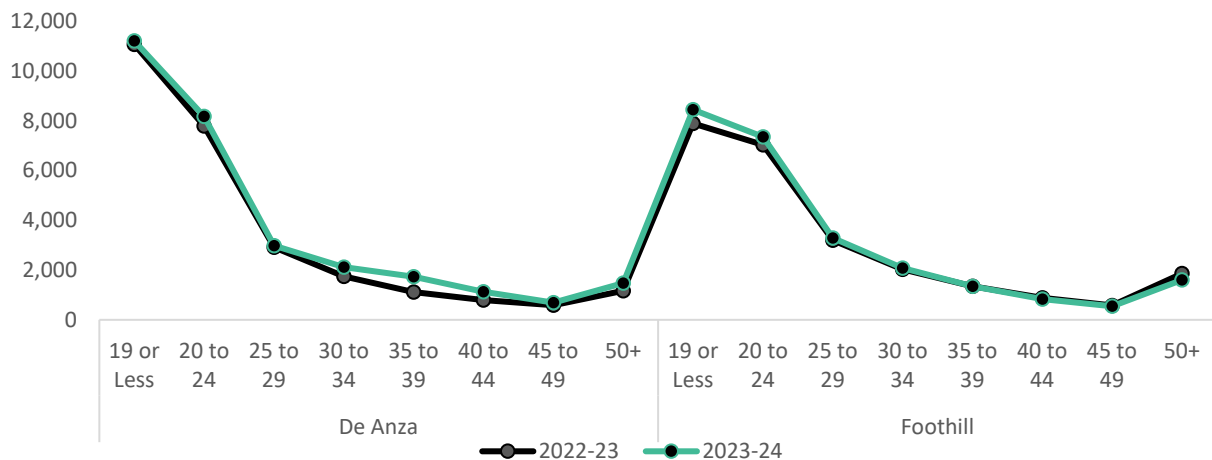

**Figure SB.A7 Student Headcount by College, Age Group and Academic Period**



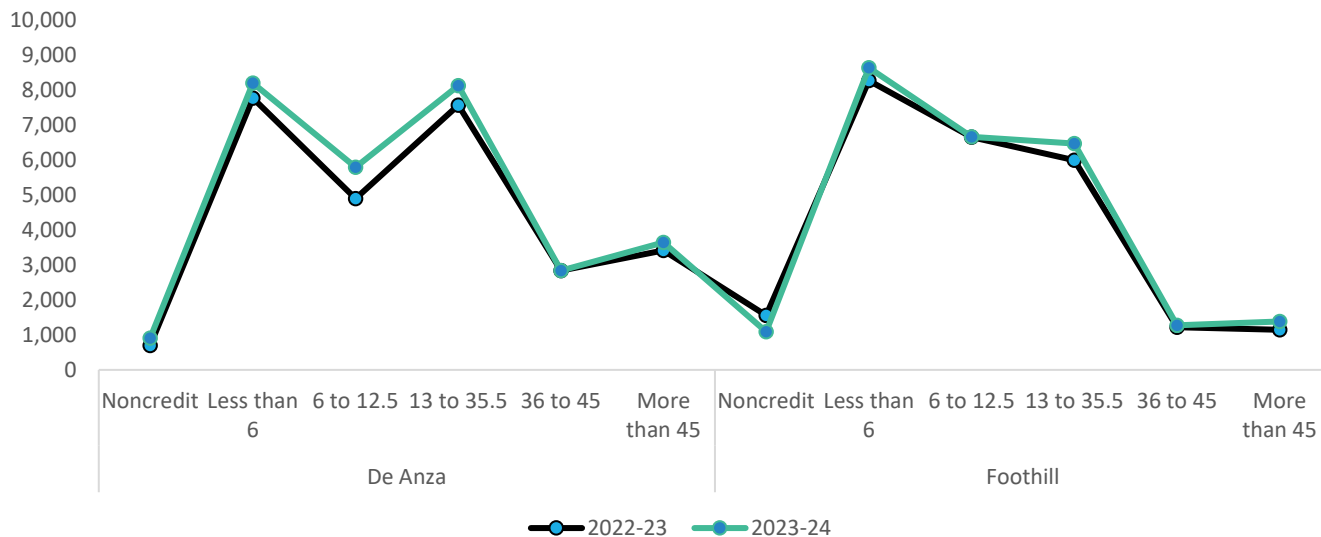

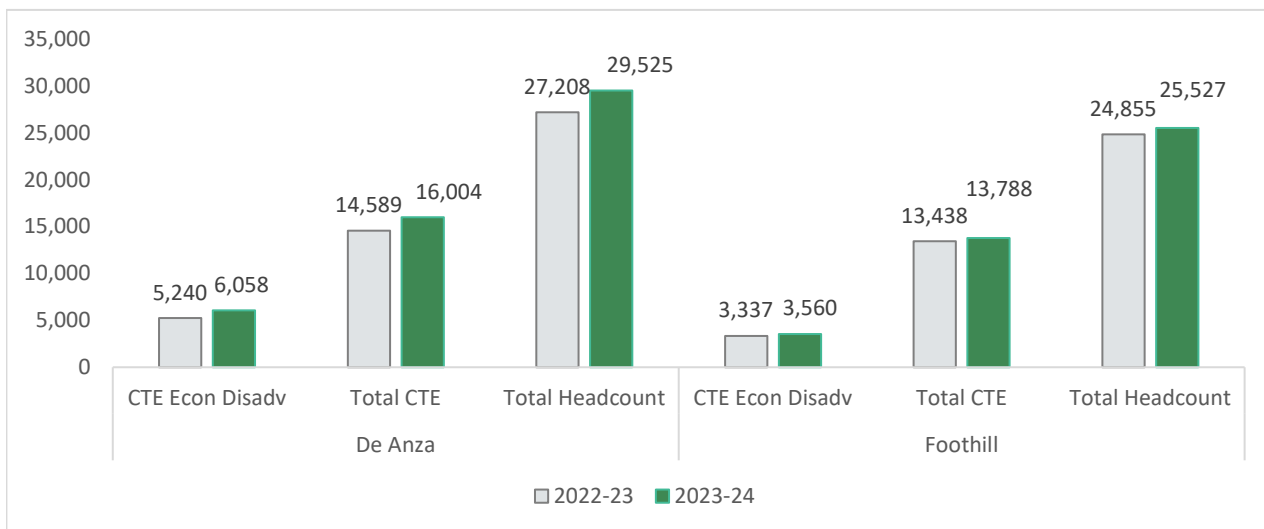

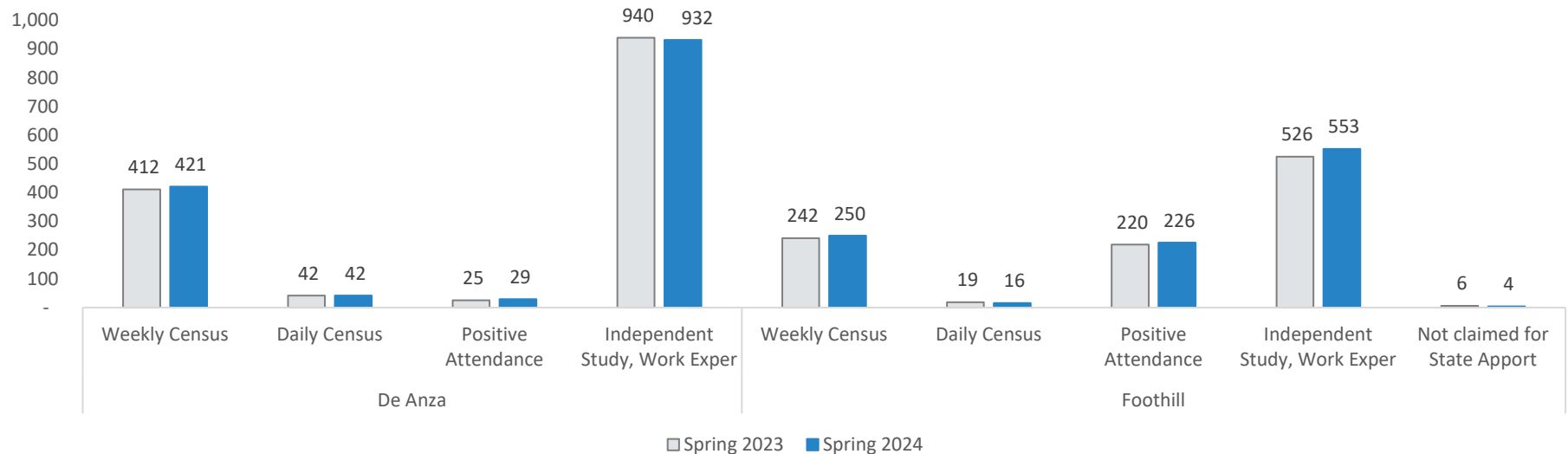

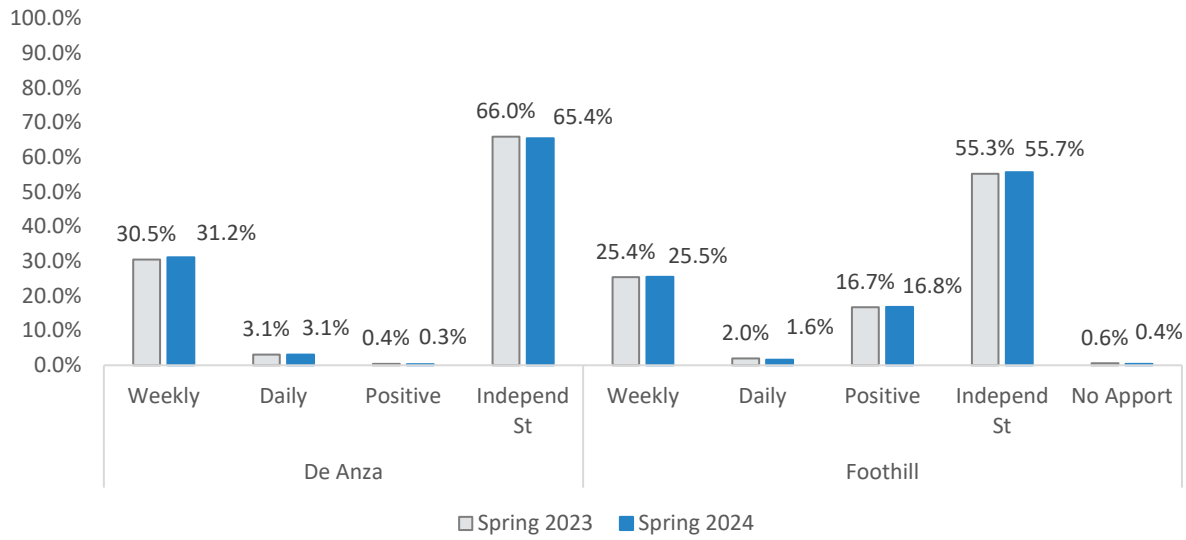

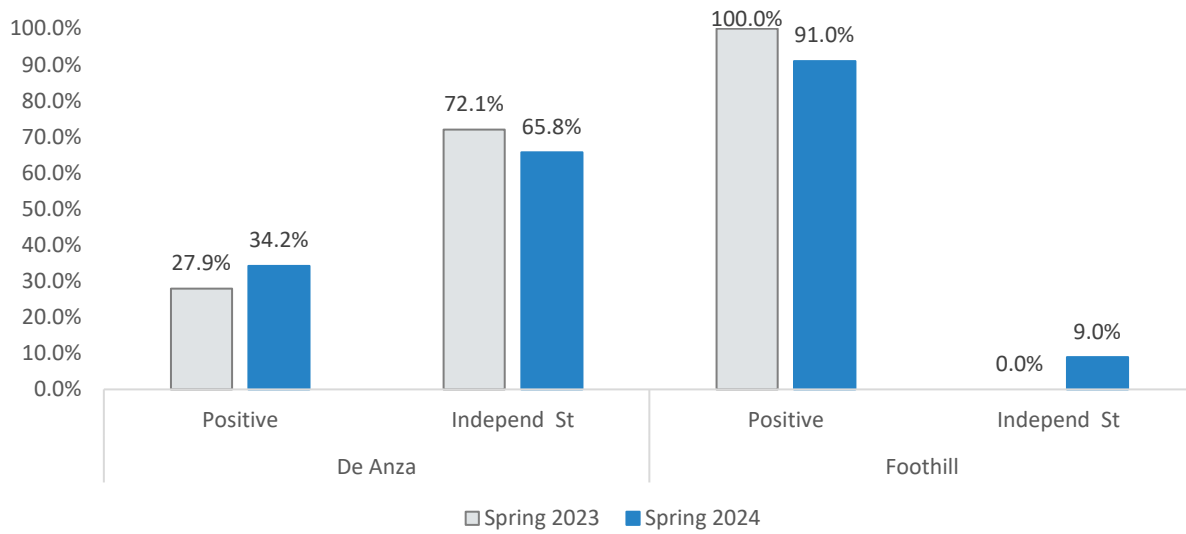

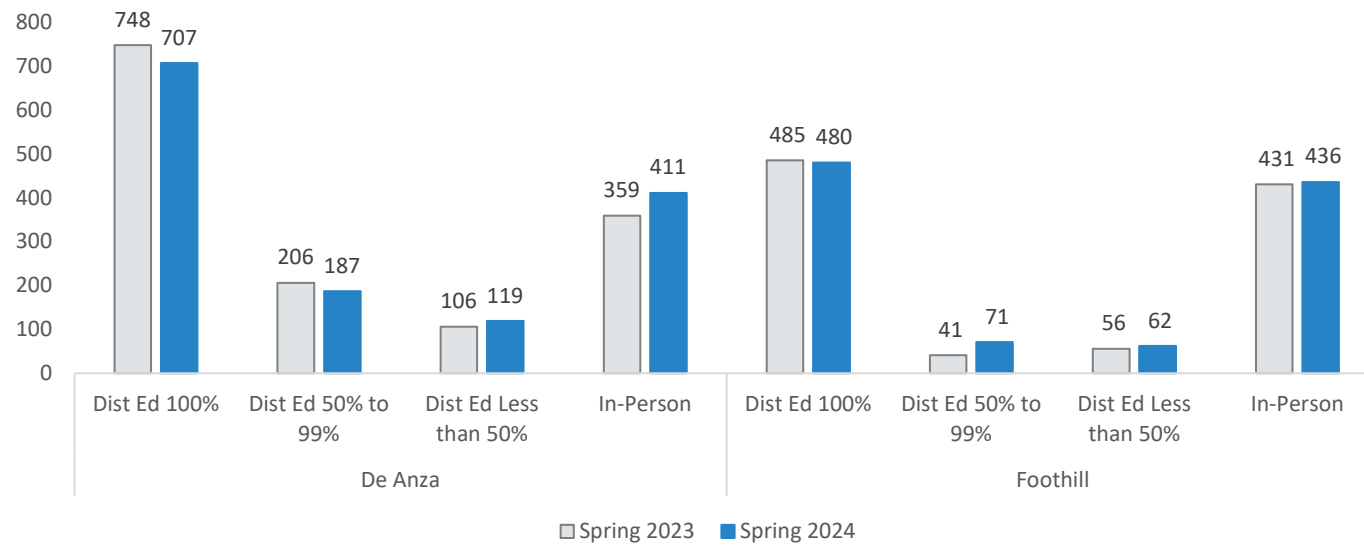

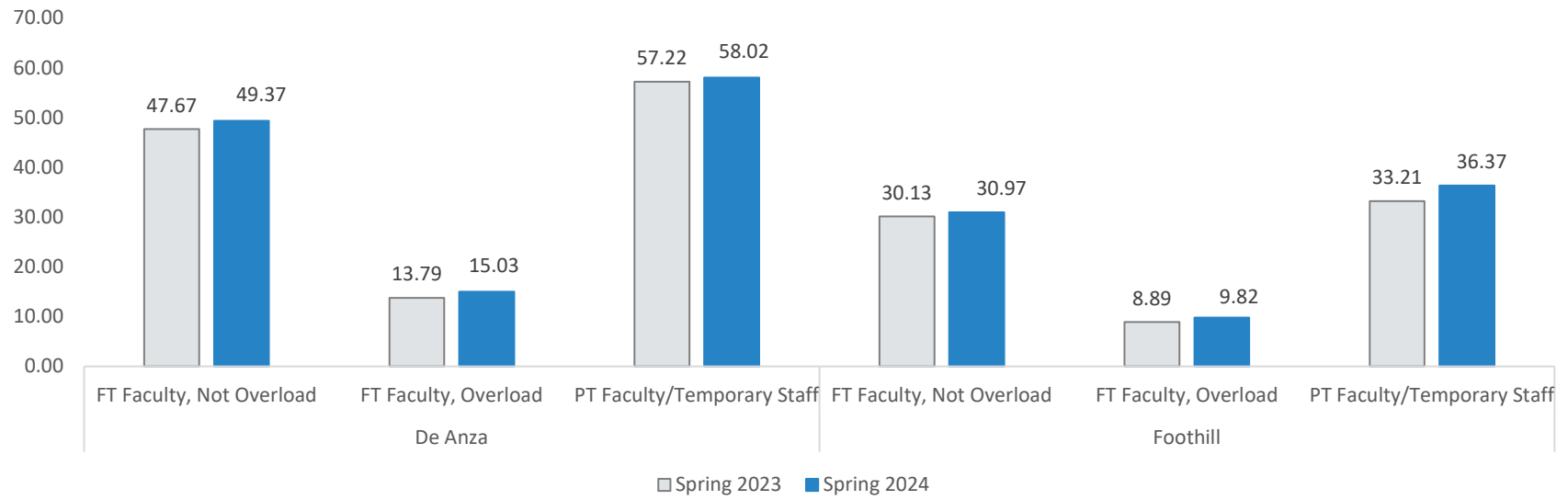

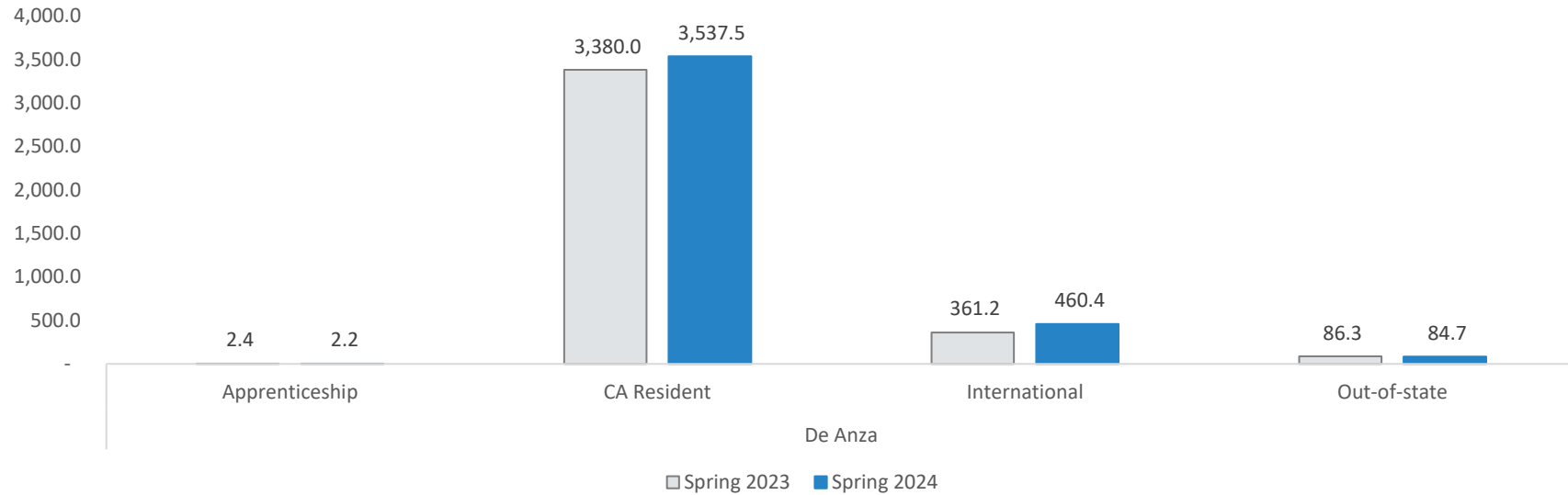
**Figure XE.1 Employee and Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Count in Credit Courses by College, Assignment Type and Academic Period**

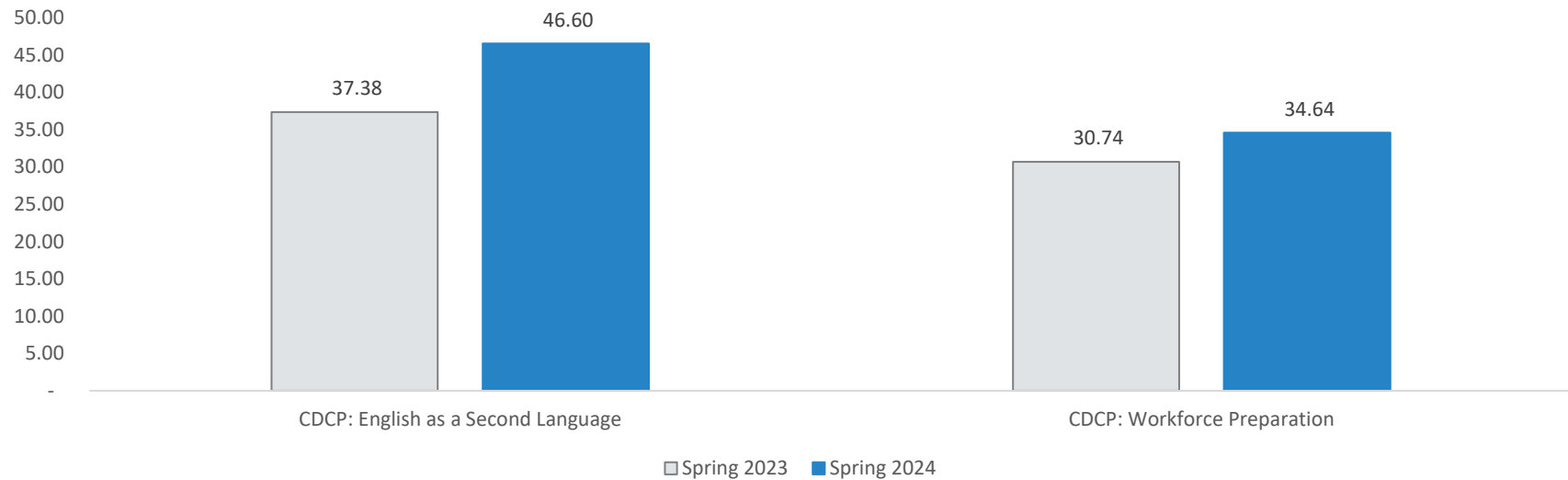
**Figure SX.1A De Anza: Credit Full-Time Equivalent Student (FTES) Estimates by Student Type and Academic Period**

**Figure SX.1B De Anza: Noncredit Full-Time Equivalent Student (FTES) Estimates by Program and Academic Period**



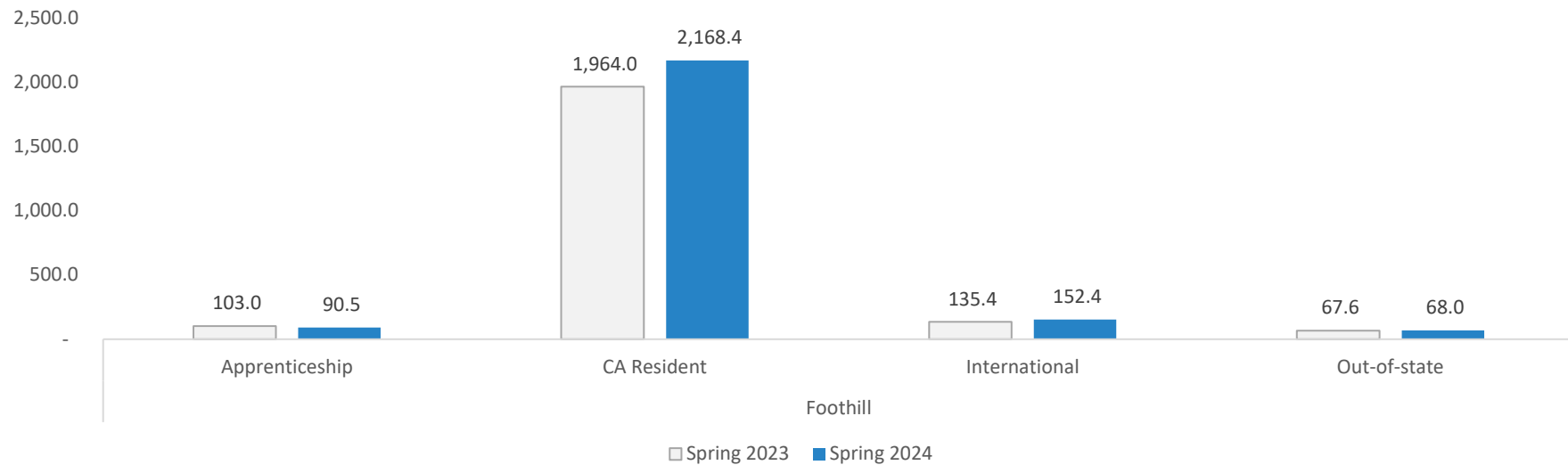

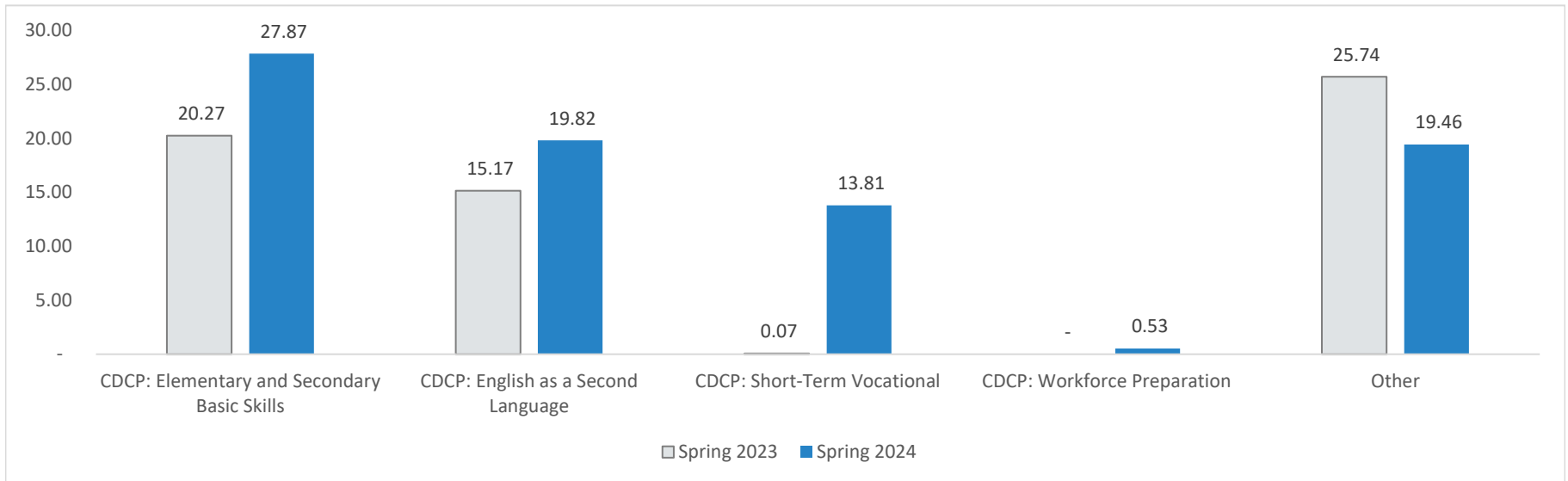
**Figure SX.2A Foothill: Credit Full-Time Equivalent Student (FTES) Estimates by Student Type and Academic Period**

**Figure SX.2B Foothill: Noncredit Full-Time Equivalent Student (FTES) Estimates by Program and Academic Period**



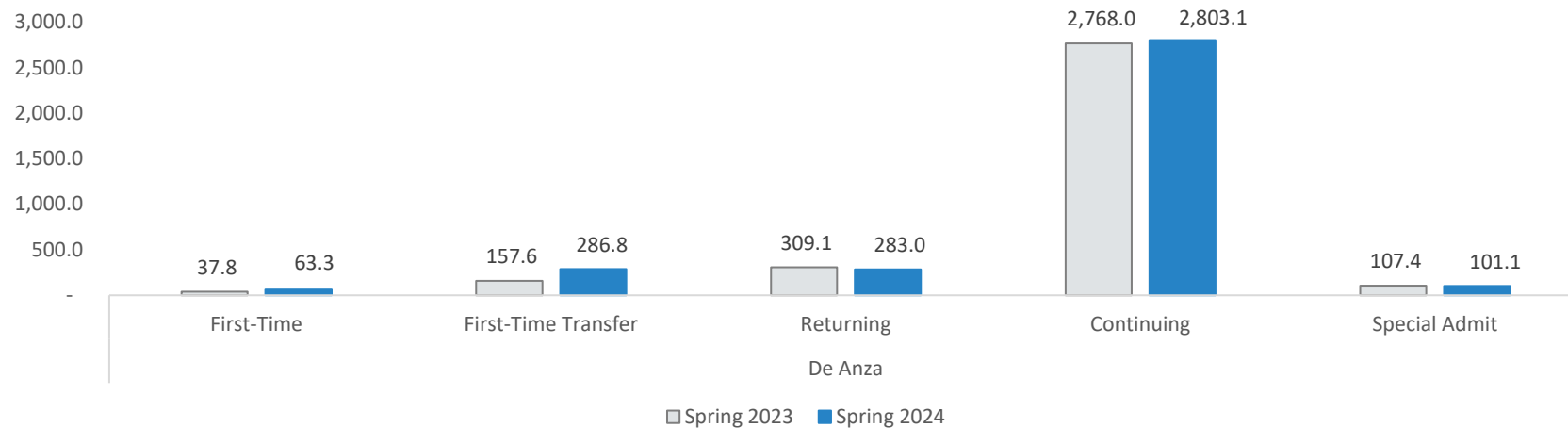

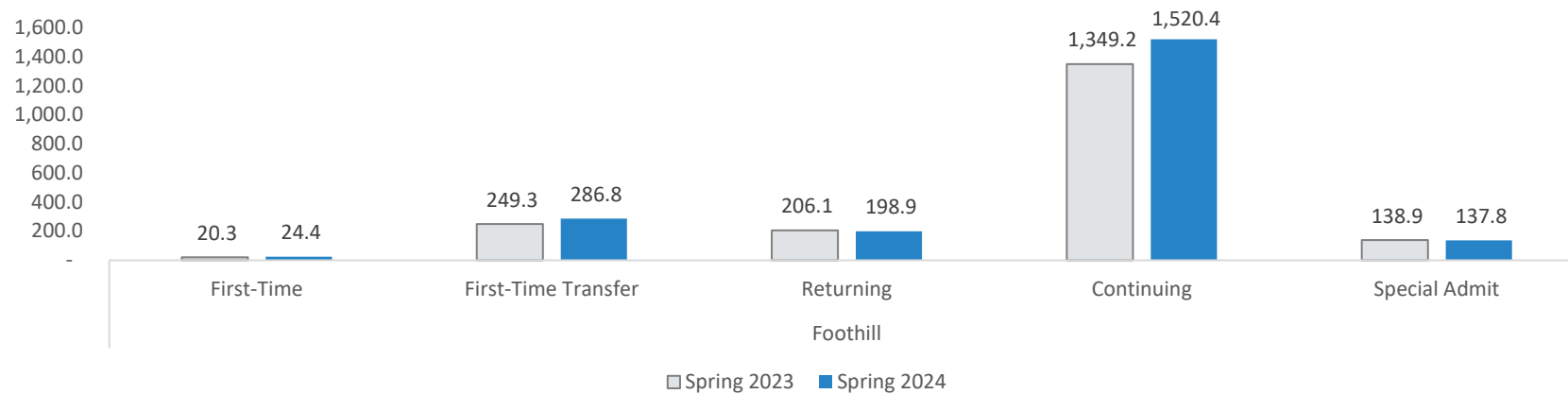

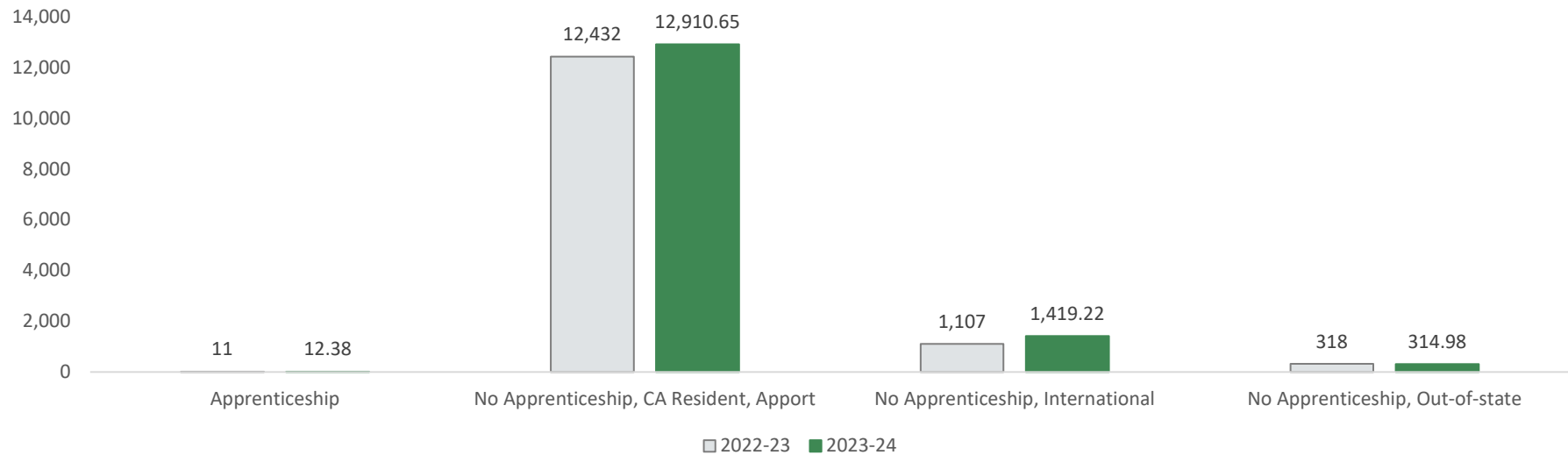

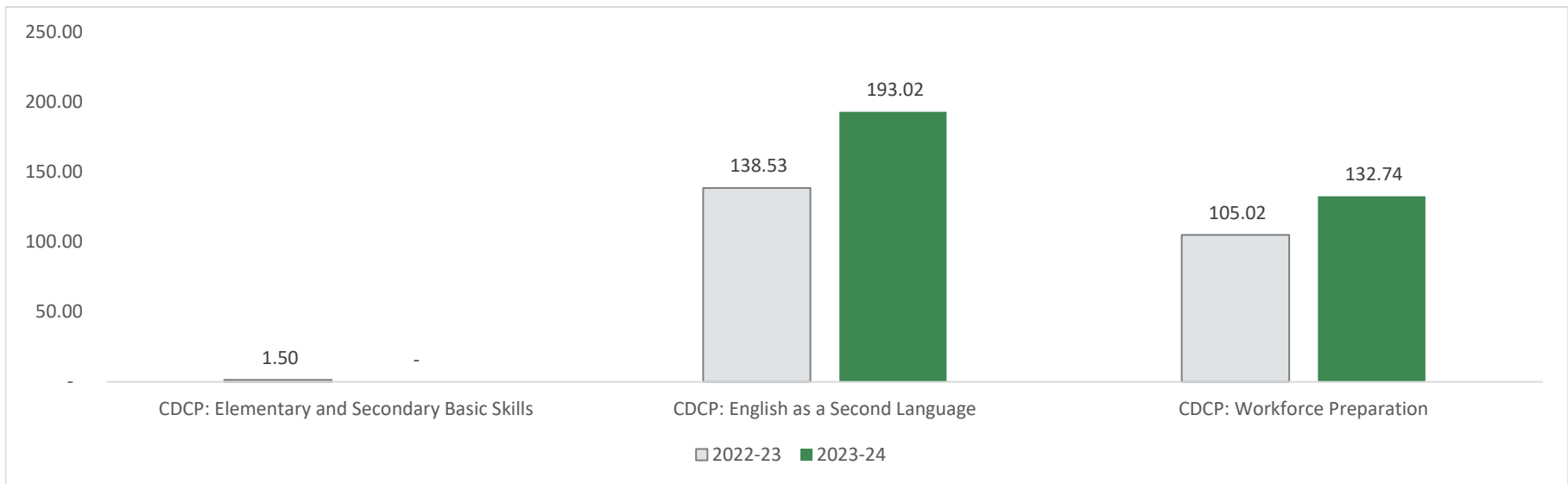

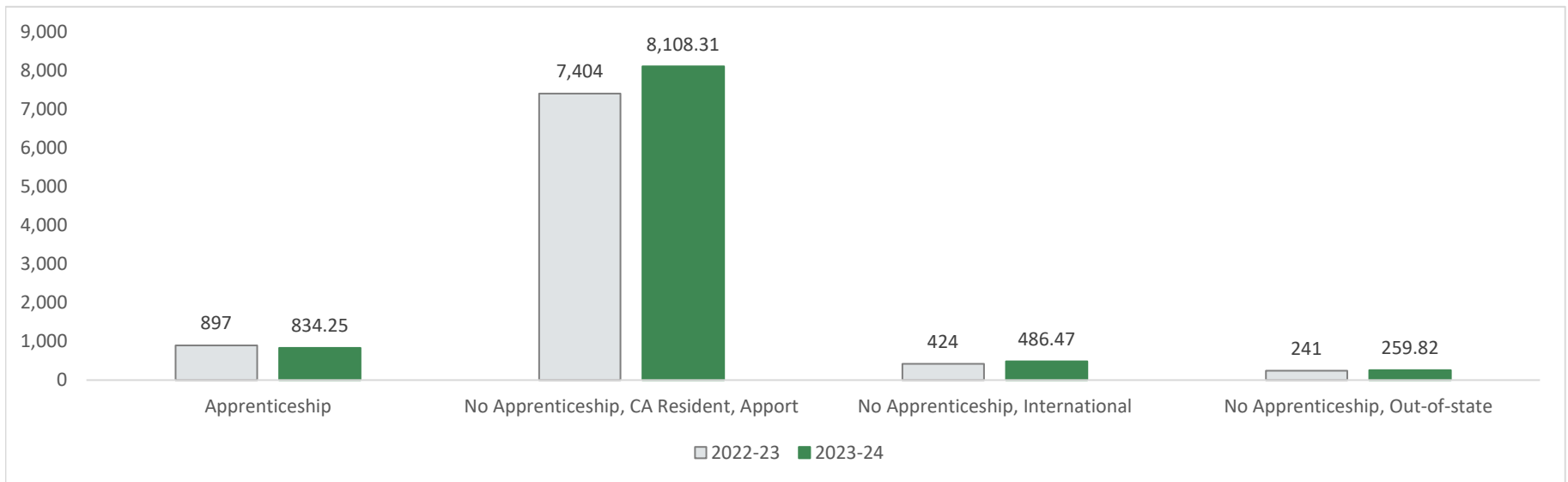
