Re: Student Headcount for Education Plan Development and Academic Probation by Academic

Year

This document provides headcount figures for students served by the DSP&S¹ Division at De Anza College during the 2013-14 and 2014-15 academic years, including headcounts for students who received services related to education plan development. A summary of findings and related tables are provided.

Statistics in this document show the following:

- In Table 1 (*DSP&S De Anza College: Student Headcount by Term and Academic Year*), figures show that 1,526 students were served by the DSP&S Division in 2014-15, a decline of about 7% when compared to figures for the prior academic year.² The fall term shows the largest decline in the number of students served (15%).
- Data in Table 2 (*DSP&S Student Headcount by Education Plan Approval Status, Term and Academic Year*) show a significant increase in the number of DSP&S students with at least one education plan in Degree Works³ for every term in 2014-15, compared to the respective term during the prior academic year. Regarding headcount or percentage change figures, winter was the term with the largest increase, especially for the approved comprehensive education plan category--16 times as many students developed a plan during this term, compared to the same term for the prior year (winter 2014, 9; winter 2015, 148).
- Regarding the percentage of DSP&S students with a comprehensive plan developed prior or during the term, figures in Table 3 (Number of DSP&S Students with a Comprehensive

Education Plan by Term and Academic Year) show significant increases for 2014-15, compared to the prior year—6% (96 out of 1634) in 2013-14; 33% (511 of 1,526) in 2014-15. Spring 2015 was the term with the largest headcount and percentage figures: 37% (384 of 1,049) of DSPS students had at least one comprehensive education plan approved on or prior this term.
