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Re: Statistics for the First Year Experience Program at De Anza College, 2015-16 to 2017-18

Introduction

This document provides statistics for the FYE (First Year Experience) program at De Anza College for the academic years between 2015-16 and 2017-18. The tables and figures in this document include data disaggregated by demographics (age, gender, race/ethnic group), enrollment status (whether the student recently graduated from high school), financial aid status (received a BOG tuition waiver or Pell grant), and academic award (was awarded a degree or certificate). Statistics are provided for the College and the FYE program by academic or cumulative year (i.e., a three year period).

The FYE (First Year Experience) program was designed for new (never attended college), first-generation (parents do not have a college degree) students who graduated from high school (or earned a GED¹) or are at least 18 years old, and have been placed into a pre-collegiate level (i.e., basic skills) English course. FYE students commit to one-year participation in this program, after attending the Summer Bridge program at the College. After their first year in the program, active FYE students receive follow-up services (e.g., counseling and education plan development).

¹ Certify that an individual's educational abilities match that of a high school level.

Key Findings

Data in Table 1 show that the FYE (First Year Experience) program had a decline of 8% in student headcount between 2015-16 and 2017-18; slightly higher than the decline in student headcount for De Anza College during the same period. On the other hand, the data also show that while the number of students in the age group “19 or less” has declined significantly, -14%, at De Anza College during this period (10,553 in 2015-16; 9,048 in 2017-18), the number of FYE students in this age group has increased significantly, 16%, during the same period (93 in 2015-16; 108 in 2017-18), as shown by figures in Table 2, Table 2.A, Figure 1, and Figure 2. In sum, data in Table 1.A show that a total of 344 students (new and continuing students) had participated in the FYE program at De Anza College between 2015-16 and 2017-18.

Specific to “New” students, those who recently graduated from high school, data in Table 3 show that while the number of recent high school graduates at De Anza College has declined significantly, -18%, during these academic years (3,742 in 2015-16; 3,059 in 2017-18), the number of “New” FYE students has declined significantly less, -6%, during the same period (54 in 2015-16; 51 in 2017-18).

Regarding gender differences, data in Table 4 show that while the number of male students at De Anza College has declined to a higher rate than that for female students between 2015-16 and 2017-18 (males, -8%; females, -4%), the opposite is shown for FYE: the number of FYE females students declined 10%, while the number of male students declined 3% during the same period. When taking into account that female students have significantly outnumbered FYE male students during the last three academic years (see Table 4.A and Figure 4), changes in headcount figures by gender in the FYE program during this period may be viewed as a positive trend toward a more equitable representation of genders.

Data for race/ethnic group in Table 5.A and Figure 5 show that the overwhelming majority of FYE student are Hispanics. In 2017-18, Hispanics made about 88% of FYE students, compared to 25% of De Anza College students (25%).

Data for financial aid in Table 6.A show that the number of FYE students who received financial aid between 2015-16 and 2017-18 ranged from 81% to 75%; compared to 32% to 36% for De Anza College. In 2017-18, data in Figure 6 show that about 72% of FYE students received a BOG or a PELL award, compared to 30% for all De Anza College students.

Academic award data in Table 8 show that of the 344 students who participated in the FYE program at De Anza College between 2015-16 and 2017-18, 78 or 23% received at least one academic award, including at least one degree (regular or for transfer). Academic award data for De Anza College and the FYE program by academic year are shown in Table 7 and Table 7.A; however, comparison of percentage figures between the College and the FYE program must take into account that a significant number of FYE students are just beginning their higher education while those included in the College statistics are most likely those who just finished their higher education or will be transferring to another institution.

De Anza College Student Headcount by Age Group and Academic Year

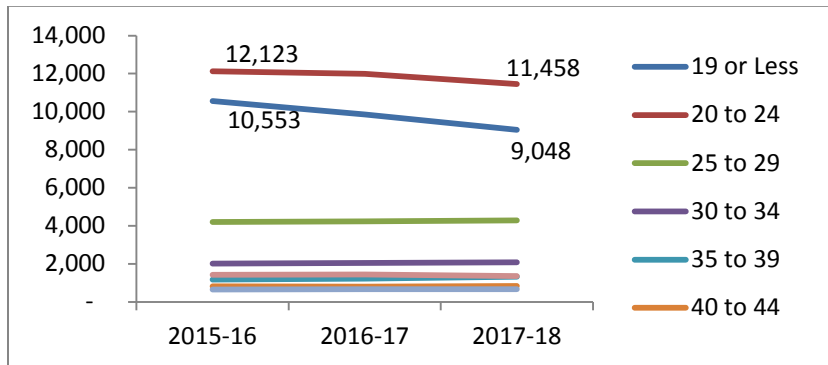

FYE Student Headcount by Age Group and Academic Year

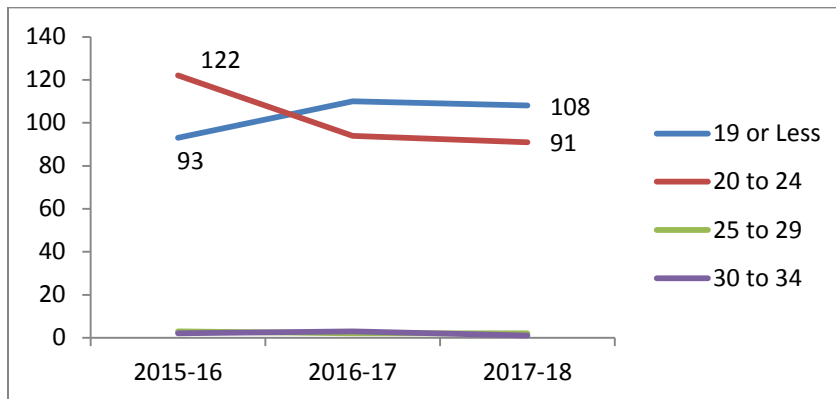

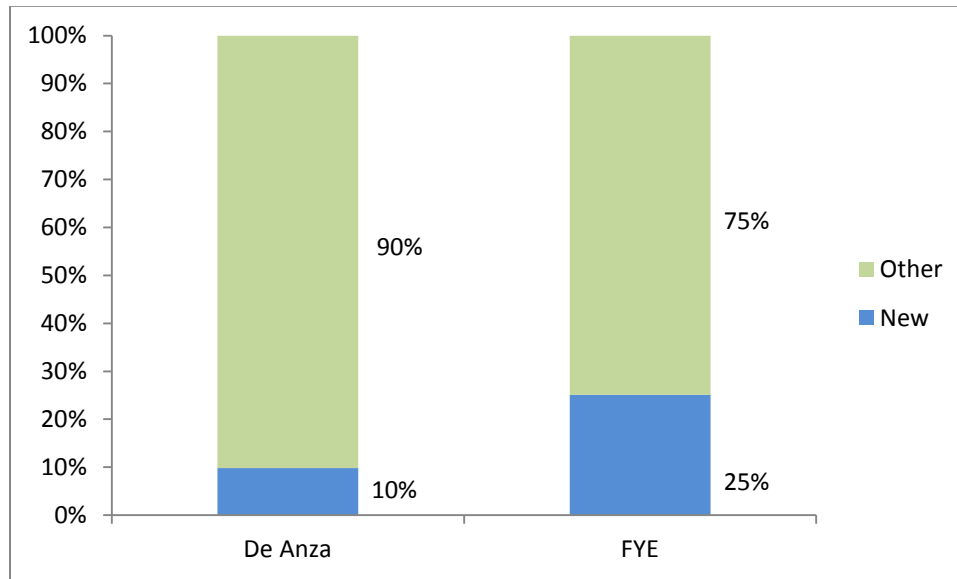

Percentage of Students for De Anza College and FYE in 2017-2018 by Gender

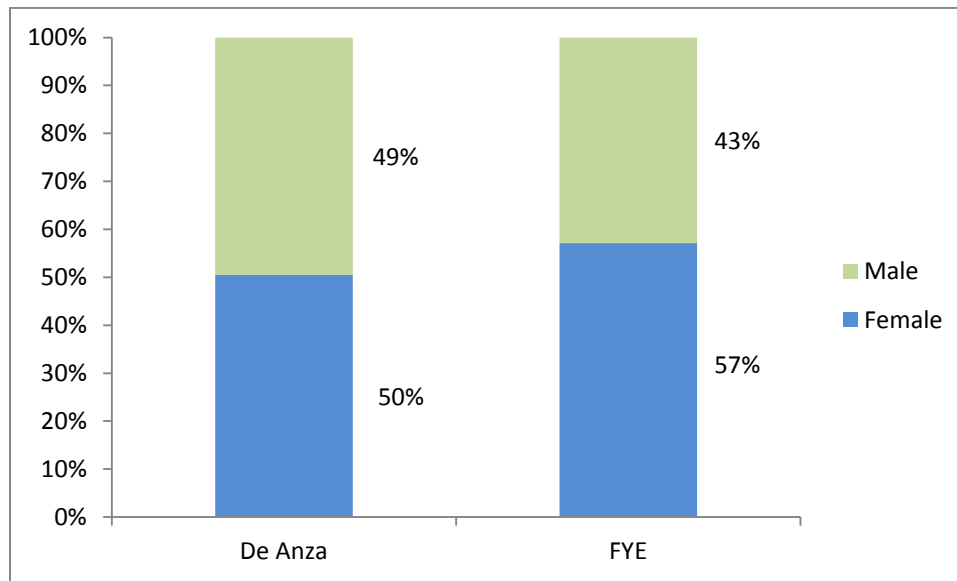

Percentage of Students for De Anza College and FYE in 2017-2018 by Race/Ethnic Group

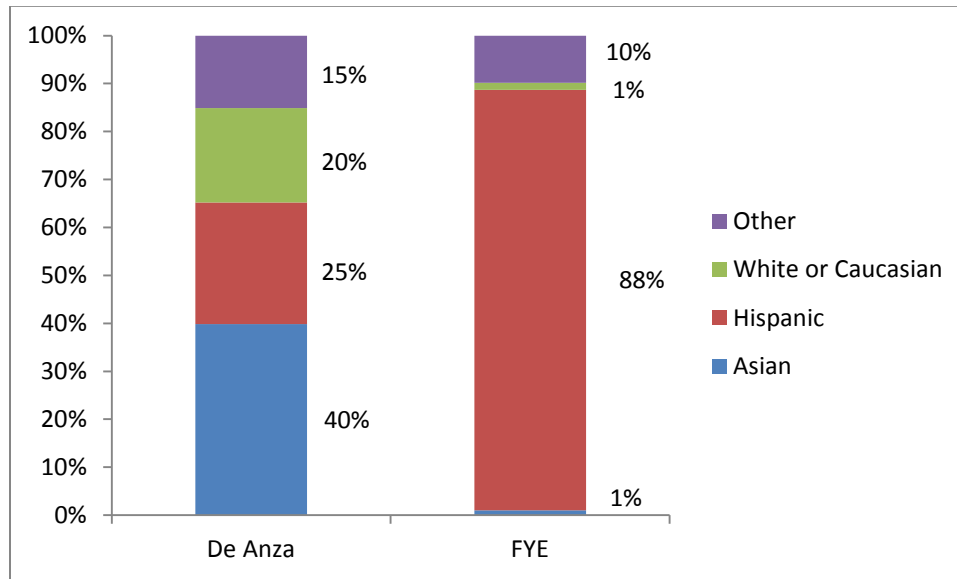

Financial Aid Status: Received BOG or Pell Award

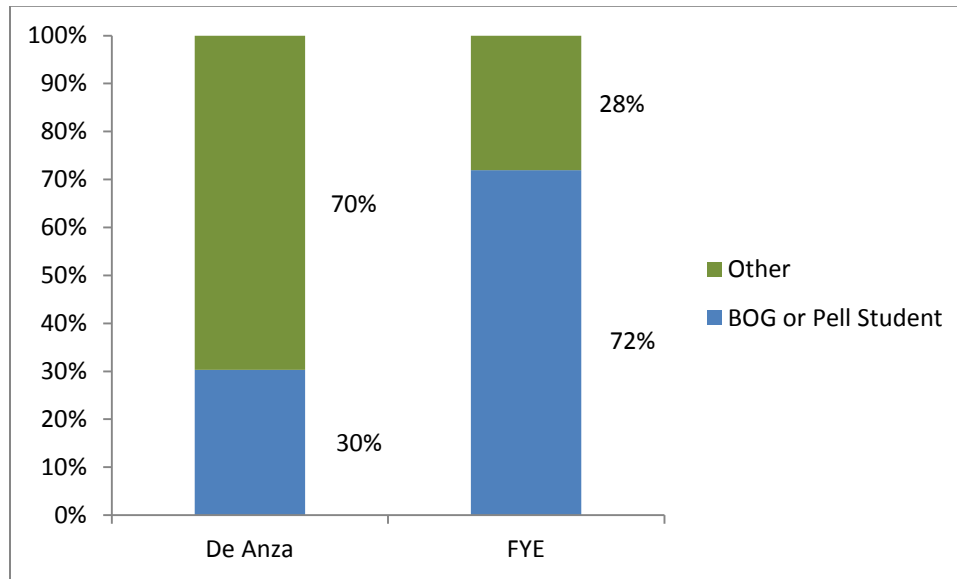
