Re: Number of students in probation who also received a BOG for winter 2016

Figures for the number of students enrolled at Foothill College or De Anza College in winter 2016 who are currently on academic probation and received a BOG type financial aid award for this quarter are as follows:

- Foothill: 197 (6%) of the 3,513 BOG students at this college are currently on academic probation.
- De Anza: 671 (8%) of the 8,453 BOG students at this college are currently on academic probation.

Data in Table 1 show headcount and percentage figures by academic probation and progress levels for both colleges, BOG students only. Figures on Table 2 show student headcount by college and BOG award type, including the total amounts for each award. Table 3 provides figures for academic probation and progress levels for the whole student population by colleges. In general, data in these tables show:

- 23% (3,513 of 14,998) of Foothill College students received at least one BOG award in winter 2016. For De Anza College, the percentage of BOG award recipients was significantly higher, 41% (8,453 of 20,589).
- 7% (1,352 of 20,589) of De Anza College students in winter 2016 are on academic probation. For Foothill College, the percentage figure for students on probation is significantly lower, 3% (488 of 14,998). When taking into account BOG recipient status, the percentage difference for students on probation is reduced (Foothill, 6%; De Anza, 8%), which suggests these difference may be accounted by differences in student demographics for the colleges.
